

We want Adult Social Care to help people better.




Helping people to live well.

Things are different now



More people live in Sheffield now. In ten years from now there will be 13,000 more old people living here.

We know we will have to help more people, and this will cost more.



We do not get enough money from Government now for Adult Social Care.



Lots of people have left Adult Social Care jobs in Sheffield.

So care services do not have enough workers.



The **Coronavirus pandemic** means family and friends are doing a lot more to help care for people.

Making our plan



Making a plan is the best way to make things better.



We have to plan for more people needing help.



We have to plan to support people who need help because of the **Coronavirus**.



We will have to support people who continue to have problems after they get the virus.



We know the Government plans to change Adult Social Care, and we will have to make these changes.

How Adult Social Care helps people



We help people who need support. They may need support with





We give early help so problems don't get worse.



We help protect people from abuse. This is called **safeguarding**.



We work closely with health services like doctors and hospitals, so the support people get works for them.



Health services are free. But most people pay for Adult Social Care.

Making it all work together



It is not just Sheffield City Council that gives Adult Social Care to people.



There are lots of services and thousands of people who make Adult Social Care work in Sheffield.



Making us all work well together is really important.



If we get this right people will get better quality support.



If we get this right, people will live well and have a good life.

How we help people



People have told us what is important when they get help from Adult Social Care. We call these our **values**.



We should be **person-centred**. This means putting the person at the centre of all we do. Making sure all our work is to help the person.




We should be **strengths-based**. This means helping the person use their skills, and the people that support them, to solve problems, live well and have a good life.



We should listen, and share information.



We should listen to what people say, keeping the good and fixing what is bad.





We should help everyone to have the information they need, so they can suggest better ways to help people.

The support we give people should be safe and good quality.





We should help people to understand how we decide what we do. We should help people to make decisions about their support.



We should **protect human rights**. This means everyone is treated with respect. Everyone is treated fairly and equally.



We should help our workers and the people we support to be creative, so they so they can choose the best way to arrange support.



We should follow the best advice, and meet good standards for care and support.

So the help we give people is the best help possible.

Our new service



Adult Social Care is a lot of services working together.



If we all work well together it is better for the people we help, and for the people working in our service.

There are lots of other ways people are helped to have a good life.



Having a good community where people support each other is important.



Good places to enjoy like parks and sports centres is important.



Good housing is important.



So our plan will look at how all these things can help make our services better.



We will make sure people can choose how they want to be supported.

We will give people information that is easy to understand.



We will value our workers and the important way they help people.



We will value our **carers** and the important way friends and family care for people every day.



We will make sure people can choose from good quality services.



We will listen to what people say, keeping the good and fixing what is bad.

What words mean

BIG words

Here are some of the words in this leaflet and what they mean.

Adult Social Care .

Our service helps adults to be independent, safe and well. We support people to live at home, and also help people who cannot live at home to move to a good quality place where they can get the help they need.

Carers .

Carers are the family, friends and neighbours that provide the support people need to help them at home. Often carers are unpaid.

Coronavirus pandemic.

This is the name of the bug (also called a virus) that has spread all over the world, making people ill.

Human Rights .

Human rights are rights and freedoms every person in the world should have. Public services like Adult Social Care and Health services have to help make sure people get their human rights. This means everyone is treated with respect, fairly and equally.

Person-centred.

Many health and social care services want everything they do to make things better for the person they are helping. We want put the person at the centre of all we do. Making sure all our work is to help them.

Safeguarding .

Keeping people safe is called Safeguarding. This means people are protected from abuse and neglect. Abuse is when someone does or says things that frighten you or cause you harm.



Many health and social care services follow this way of working. Instead of just asking about the problems a person has, we also ask about the good things in their life, and what helps them to live well. We then help the person use their skills, and the people that support them, to solve problems, live well and have a good life.
