NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 30th day of March, 2023 the Sheffield City Council made the above Orders which come into operation on the 3rd day of April, 2023 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders will be to introduce:

- Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Places on parts of Albert Road Car Park, Broomspring Lane Car Park, Ebenezer Street Car Park, Fitzwilliam Street Car Park, Lancing Road Car Park, Shipton Street Car Park, Spooner Road Car Park, Stewart Road Car Park, Trinity Street Car Park and Windrush Way Car Park;
- Off-Street Parking Places on parts of Heart of the Campus and The Mews Car Park;
- The power to suspend the use of Parking Places in all the off-street car parks;
- Updated Schedule for all off-street car parks.

And remove:

- Off-Street Parking Places on parts of Clun Road Car Park, 33 Collegiate Crescent Car Park, Grimesthorpe Road South Car Park, Marshall Hall – Collegiate Crescent, Montgomery House – 32 Collegiate Crescent and Yorkon Building – Broomgrove Road Car Park.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 3rd April 2023 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

(AMENDMENT NO.15) ORDER 2023

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (Off Street Car Park) (Control of Use) Order 2002 shall have effect as though:-

a) In Definitions, Article 2, thereto there was included the following items:-

“Electric Vehicle” means a vehicle which

i) is an exempt vehicle for the purposes of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 in accordance with paragraph 20G (electrically propelled vehicles) of Schedule 2 to that Act; or

ii) the Council is satisfied is capable of operation wholly by means of an electrically powered propulsion system that draws its motive power from either a hydrogen fuel cell or from a battery without using its internal combustion engine;

“Electric Vehicle Only Place” means a place duly marked and signed adjacent to an Electric Vehicle Charging Post in an area of land specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order and authorised to be used as parking place by the provisions of this Order by an Electric Vehicle. The Electric Vehicle is required to be actively charging and be connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post by way of a connected lead and said post indicates the vehicle is charging.

“Electric Vehicle Charging Post” means an installation adjacent to an Electric Vehicle Charging Only Place for the purpose of charging the battery of an Electric Vehicle by way of a connected lead that can indicate that a payment has been made and it is in operation;

“Parking Bay” means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle;

b) In Article 6 item (iv) thereto there was substituted the following item:-

(iv) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order any vehicle of a class specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to this Order with respect to which a parking permit, Green Permit or Virtual Parking Permit has been issued by the Council may be left in a parking place described in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order during the charging hours without further charge provided that :-

(i) The parking permit, Green Permit or Virtual Parking Permit is valid and is being used with respect to the vehicle for which it was issued, and

(ii) The parking permit, Green Permit or Virtual Parking Permit is being used in the manner directed by the Council in accordance with instructions given on signs, machines or by any other manner.

c) In Article 9 thereto there was substituted the following item:-

9. Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful for any class of vehicle specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to this Order to park within any parking place specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order:-

d) In Article 6 thereto there was included the following item:-

(vi) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle

other than an Electric Vehicle to park in any parking place which is designated as an Electric Vehicles Only Place and is marked in accordance with the regulations. At all times the Electric Vehicle whilst parked within an Electric Vehicle Only Place:

- (i) must be actively charging;
 - (ii) must be connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post in by way of a connected lead and said post indicates the vehicle is charging;
 - (iii) must of paid the parking charge in accordance with the provisions of this Order
- e) In Article 9 thereto there was included the following items:-
- (iii) The vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
 - (iv) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (v) At any time except in an Electric Vehicle Only Place that is duly marked and signed adjacent to an Electric Vehicle Charging Post unless it is an Electric Vehicle that is actively charging and connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post by way of a connected lead and said post indicates the vehicle is charging.
- f) In the Articles thereto there was included the following items:-

Suspension of Parking Places

- 16 a) The Council may suspend the use of a parking place described in Schedule listed in Column 1 of this Order if such suspension is deemed by the Council to be reasonably necessary for:-
- i) the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - ii) the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line or traffic sign or ticket issuing machine;
 - iii) the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - iv) any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any parking place will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - v) the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions; or
 - vi) any other reason/occasion considered necessary by the Council, acting reasonably and as determined from time to time.
- b) Where the use of a parking place or any part thereof is suspended pursuant to paragraph a) of this Article, the Council or any person authorised on its behalf shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that parking place a traffic sign indicating that it is suspended and that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

- c) On any suspension of the use of a parking place described in the Schedule listed in Column 1 to this Order or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (a) of this Article, any person duly authorised by the Council may temporarily remove any ticket issuing machine relating to any parking bay within that parking place or, as the case may be, that part thereof and any post, bracket or other support on which that ticket issuing machine is fitted and shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking bay a traffic sign giving the indication referred to in paragraph (b) of this Article.
- d) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left –
- i) In a parking bay during such period as there is over the ticket issuing machine relating to that bay a hood or other cover indicating that the use of the bay is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent to that bay a traffic sign place in pursuance of paragraph (c) of this Article;
- ii) In any part of a parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that part of the parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (b) of this Article;

Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit:

- 1) a vehicle to be left in the parking bay during either such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (i) or in the part of a parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (ii) if the vehicle is left within the permission (1) of the person suspending the use of the parking place or the part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (a) of this Article or (2) of a civil enforcement officer; or
- 2) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Articles (9) (ii) and (iv) of this Order to be left in a parking during either such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (i) or in the part of the parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (ii).

- g) For the Schedule thereto there was substituted the Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of April, 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Off Street Car Park) (Control of Use) Order 2002 (Amendment No.15) Order 2023.

3. No vehicle other than an Electric Vehicle shall be parked within an “Electric Vehicle Only Place” which is duly marked and signed adjacent to an Electric Vehicle Charging Post. The Electric Vehicle is required to be actively charging and be connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post by way of a connected lead and said post indicates the vehicle is charging and the appropriate charge for that parking place has been paid.

(AMENDMENT NO.42) ORDER 2023

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124(1)(c), (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (off-Street Parking Places) Order 1979 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-

a) In Interpretation, Article 2 item (1) thereto there was included the following items:-

"Electric Vehicle" means a vehicle which

- i) is an exempt vehicle for the purposes of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 in accordance with paragraph 20G (electrically propelled vehicles) of Schedule 2 to that Act; or
- ii) the Council is satisfied is capable of operation wholly by means of an electrically powered propulsion system that draws its motive power from either a hydrogen fuel cell or from a battery without using its internal combustion engine;

"Electric Vehicle Only Place" means a place duly marked and signed adjacent to an Electric Vehicle Charging Post in an area of land specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order and authorised to be used as parking place by the provisions of this Order by an Electric Vehicle. The Electric Vehicle is required to be actively charging and be connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post by way of a connected lead and said post indicates the vehicle is charging.

"Electric Vehicle Charging Post" means an installation adjacent to an Electric Vehicle Charging Only Place for the purpose of charging the battery of an Electric Vehicle by way of a connected lead that can indicate that a payment has been made and it is in operation;

b) In Article (9) items (1) and (7) thereto there was substituted the following items:-

(1) The driver of a vehicle of a class specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to this Order left in any of the parking places referred to in Column 1 of the Schedule for a period not in excess of that allowed for the said parking place in Column 5 of the Schedule shall not contravene this Order provided that the driver has, on leaving the vehicle in a parking bay, paid the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Column 2 of the Schedule, and shown on the Tariff Board on display within the parking place, and complied with all other conditions of use displayed on that Tariff Board and the requirements of this Order.

(7) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order any vehicle of a class specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to this Order with respect to which a parking permit, Green Permit or Virtual Parking Permit has been issued by the city council may be left in a parking place described in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order during the charging hours without further charge provided that :-

- (i) The parking permit, Green Permit or Virtual Parking Permit is valid and is being used with respect to the vehicle for which it was issued, and
- (ii) The parking permit, Green Permit or Virtual Parking Permit is being used in the manner directed by the council in accordance with instructions given on signs, machines or by any other manner.

c) In Article 9 thereto there was included the following items:-

(9) (9)(A) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order no person shall cause or permit

any vehicle other than an Electric Vehicle to park in any parking place which is designated as an Electric Vehicles Only Place and is marked in accordance with the regulations. At all times the Electric Vehicle whilst parked within an Electric Vehicle Only Place:

- (i) it must be actively charging;
- (ii) must be connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post in by way of a connected lead and said post indicates the vehicle is charging;
- (iii) must of paid the parking charge in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

(9)(B) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order, a vehicle which is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;

(9)(C) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order, the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

d) In the Articles thereto there was included the following items:-

Suspension of Parking Places

- (31) a) The Council may suspend the use of a parking place described in Schedule listed in Column 1 of this Order if such suspension is deemed by the Council to be reasonably necessary for:-
- (i) the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (ii) the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply or gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line or traffic sign or ticket issuing machine;
 - (iii) the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (iv) any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any parking place will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - (v) the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
 - vi) any other reason/occasion considered necessary by the Council, acting reasonably and as determined from time to time.
- b) Where the use of a parking place or any part thereof is suspended pursuant to paragraph a) of this Article, the Council or any person authorised on its behalf shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that parking place a traffic sign indicating that it is suspended and that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- c) On any suspension of the use of a parking place described in the Schedule listed in Column 1 to this Order or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (a) of this Article, any person duly authorised by the

Council may temporarily remove any ticket issuing machine relating to any parking bay within that parking place or, as the case may be, that part thereof and any post, bracket or other support on which that ticket issuing machine is fitted and shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking bay a traffic sign giving the indication referred to in paragraph (b) of this Article.

- d) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left –
 - (i) In a parking bay during such period as there is over the ticket issuing machine relating to that bay a hood or other cover indicating that the use of the bay is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent to that bay a traffic sign place in pursuance of paragraph (c) of this Article;
 - (ii) In any part of a parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that part of the parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (b) of this Article;
- e) Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit:
 - (1) a vehicle to be left in the parking bay during either such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (i) or in the part of a parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (ii) if the vehicle is left within the permission (1) of the person suspending the use of the parking place or the part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (a) of this Article or (2) of a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (2) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Articles (9)(A) and (9)(B) of this Order to be left in a parking during either such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (i) or in the part of the parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (ii).

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of April, 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (off-Street Parking Places) Order 1979 (Amendment No.42) Order 2023.

Permit Parking

When denoted on signs displayed within a car park a vehicle may be parked without further payment of Pay and Display charges on that car park provided that the vehicle is:-

- displaying a valid parking permit issued by the City Council with respect to that car park,
- for a charge to be determined by the City Council, and
- the permit is being used in a manner directed by the City Council

CLASSES OF VEHICLES (COLUMN 3)

A: Passenger vehicles, motor cycle combinations and good vehicles not exceeding 30 cwts unladen.

B: Electric Vehicles

DAYS/HOURS OF OPERATION (COLUMN 4)

The standard hours of operation are: Monday – Sunday 0800 – 2030 unless otherwise displayed on signs within the car park.

POSITION IN WHICH VEHICLES MAY PARK

All vehicles shall park in a marked parking bay, or if no such bay exists, in a position so as not to prevent the free movement of other vehicles into or out of or on the car park or to interfere with the proper parking of other vehicles. No vehicle shall be parked where double yellow lines or areas hatched in yellow indicate a Prohibition of Waiting.

No vehicle shall be parked within a parking bay marked with a disabled symbol unless displaying a valid disabled persons' badge.

No vehicle other than an Electric Vehicle shall be parked within an "Electric Vehicle Only Place" which is duly marked and signed adjacent to an Electric Vehicle Charging Post. The Electric Vehicle is required to be actively charging and be connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post by way of a connected lead and said post indicates the vehicle is charging and the appropriate charge for that parking place has been paid.

NOTE: There is no change to the 'Scale of Charges'

1. The Sheffield City Council (Various Roads and Off-Street Car Parks) (Electric Vehicle Parking Places) Order 2021 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-

a) In Article (10)(a)(vi) thereto there was substituted the following item:-

vi) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in Article 10(a)(ii) of this Section;

b) In Schedule 1 there was included the following item:-

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of April, 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Various Roads and Off-Street Car Parks) (Electric Vehicle Parking Places) Order 2021 (Amendment No.1) Order 2023.
