

THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL
(HIGHFIELD) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 29th day of June 2023 the Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 3rd day of July 2023 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the whole or on parts of Baron Street, Charlotte Road, Cherry Street, Cherry Street South, Clough Bank, Clough Road, Countess Road, Cream Street, Cromford Street, Edmund Road, John Street, Lancing Road, Margaret Street, Midland Street, Priestley Street, Rowsley Street, Shoreham Street, Silver Mill Road, St Wilfrid's Road and Store Street.

A copy of the Order may be examined during normal opening hours at First Point Reception, Howden House, 1 Union Street, Sheffield, S1 2SH or within the **Sealed Traffic Orders** section on the Council website at <https://www.sheffield.gov.uk/home/roads-pavements/traffic-orders>

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 29th June 2023 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

(HIGHFIELD) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 having given public notice in accordance with subsection (2) of that section and schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when use in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of July 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Highfield) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023.
