(AMENDMENT NO.159) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 20th day of July 2023 the Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 24th day of July 2023 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce:

- Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time on parts of Burton Street and Priestley Street;
- Permit holders only parking, Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm on part of Priestley Street;
- Disabled parking bays on parts of Britannia Road (Darnall) and Chapel Street;
- Loading Bay on part of Burton Street;

And remove:

- Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time on parts of Britannia Road and Priestley Street;
- No loading at any time on part of Britannia Road;
- Permit holders only parking Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm on part of Priestley Street.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 20th day of July 2023 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124(1)(c), (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part 111 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (Consolidation) (On-Street Parking and Prohibition of Waiting) (Outer Area) Order 2008 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-
 - a) In Schedule 1.01A thereto for the item '51. Priestley Street – The east side (ii)' there was substituted the following item:-

51. Priestley Street	The east side:	
	(ii)	From a point 10 metres north of its junction with the northern kerb line of Cream Street to a point 4 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Cream Street.
 - b) In Schedule 1.01D thereto for the item '1066 Church Lane – the north side (i)' there was substituted the following item:-

1066. Church Lane	The north side:	
	(i)	From a point 5 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Tithe Barn Lane to its junction with Chapel Street.
 - c) In Schedule 1.01L thereto for the item '1731 Britannia Road – the south side (ii)' there was substituted the following item:-

1731. Britannia Road	The south side:	
	(ii)	From a point 45 metres south-east of its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Main Road for a distance of 23 metres in a south easterly direction.
 - d) In Schedule 3.01 thereto for the item '8 Britannia Road - the south side (i)' there was substituted the following item:-

8. Britannia Road	The south side:	
	(i)	From a point 45 metres south-east of its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Main Road for a distance of 23 metres in a south easterly direction.
 - e) In Schedule 19.03 thereto for the item '48A. Priestley Street - The west side (ii)' there was substituted the following item:-

48A. Priestley Street	The west side:	
	(ii)	From a point 8 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Store Street to a point 24 metres south of its junction with the projected southern kerb line of Cream Street.

f) In Schedule 1.01A thereto there were included the following items:-

51. Priestley Street

The west side:

- (ii) From a point 24 metres south of its junction with the projected southern kerb line of Cream Street for a distance of 16 metres in a southerly direction.

g) In Schedule 1.01D thereto there was included the following item:-

1063. Chapel Street

The north side:

- (i) From its junction with Church Lane to a point 20 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of Vicar Lane.

h) In Schedule 1.01H thereto there was included the following item:-

1336. Burton Street

The north west side:

- (ii) From a point 66 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Blackburne Street for a distance of 36 metres in a north easterly direction.

The south east side:

- (ii) From a point 50 metres north east of the projected north eastern kerb line of Blackburne Street for a distance of 50 metres in a north easterly direction

i) In Schedule 7.01 thereto there were included the following items:-

The south west side of Britannia Road which is bounded on the southwest side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway, from a point 30 metres southeast of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Main Road for a distance of 15 metres in a south-easterly direction.

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The north side of Chapel Street which is bounded on the north side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway, from a point 20 metres west of its junction with the south western kerb line of Vicar Lane for a distance of 8.5 metres in a westerly direction.

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j) In Schedule 11.01 Thereto there was included the following item:

1A. Burton Street

The north west side:

From a point 9 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Blackburne Street for a distance of 10 metres in a north easterly direction.

k) In Schedule 19.03 thereto there was included the following item:-

48A Priestley Street

The east side:

(iii) From a point 4 metres south of Cream Street for a distance of 16 metres in a southerly direction.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of July 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Consolidation) (On-Street Parking and Prohibition of Waiting) (Outer Area) Order 2008 (Amendment No.159) Order 2023.
