## **LICENSING ACT 2003**

## **APPLY FOR AN INTERIM AUTHORITY NOTICE**

1. Complete the form headed "Interim authority notice under the Licensing Act 2003" along with the privacy statement.

An interim notice may only be given either by a person with a prescribed interest in the premises, or by a person connected to the former holder of the licence (normally a personal representative of the former holder or a person with power of attorney or where someone has become insolvent that persons insolvency practitioner).

- 2. Right to work documentation If the applicant is an individual, proof that they have right to work in this country must also be supplied with the application or the 9-digit 'share code' for the Home Office online right to work checking service. More information on this can be found at the end of the application guidance.
- **3.** Pay a fee of £23 with the application.
- 4. The completed application and supporting documents must be submitted to:
