APPLICATION TO DISAPPLY A DESIGNATED PREMISES SUPERVISOR FROM A COMMUNITY PREMISES

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Complete the form headed "Application for the mandatory alcohol condition under the Licensing Act 2003 requiring a designated premises supervisor in respect of a premises licence to be disapplied" along with the privacy statement. The application must be made by the committee or board with responsibility for the management of the community premises.
- 2. For premises already holding a licence with a named DPS, you must pay a fee of £23 with this application.

If you are completing this form as part of a new premises licence or a full variation to your existing premises licence, you do not pay a fee.

- **3.** The **original** premises licence and summary must be enclosed with the application so that it can be amended. These must be the originals. If this is not possible, please include a statement of the reasons for the failure to provide the licence on the form. You may be required to apply for a duplicate.
- **4.** Enclose any documents (if available) which identify the premises and how this is managed along with copies of any hiring agreements.
