Registers of Crematoria and Burials in Civil Cemeteries

Introduction

The Guide lists registers of creations and burials in civil cemeteries. Civil cemeteries, usually administered by local authorities, began to be established in the mid 19th century, particularly in urban areas where parish church and chapel yards were becoming overcrowded. The first civil cemetery in Sheffield was the General Cemetery which opened in 1836. Cemeteries in Attercliffe, Darnall and Handsworth opened in 1859, with Burngeave following in 1861. Thereafter, new cemeteries were opened as required.

Prior to the mid 19th century most burials took place in church or chapel yards. Registers of burials in Anglican parishes can date back to 1538. For details of Anglican parish registers held at Sheffield Archives refer to Family History Guide 4 – Parish Registers. For details of non-conformist chapel burials (Methodist, Quaker etc), please see Family History Guide 6 – Non-Conformist Registers.

Other records of interest are Monumental Inscriptions (transcripts of information recorded on headstones and other memorials). Please refer to Family History Guide 2 – Monumental Inscriptions for further details.
