# <u>THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL</u> (ALMA STREET, BALL STREET AND GREEN LANE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 2022 The Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2022 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce:

- Prohibition of Driving on parts of Alma Street and Ball Street,
- One Way Traffic on part of Green Lane.

The restrictions will remove motor vehicle through traffic in Kelham Island and Neepsend. This will lead to improved amenity within Kelham Island and Neepsend, for the benefit of both residents and visitors and will improve the environment for walking and cycling.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

#### THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL (ALMA STREET, BALL STREET AND GREEN LANE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 9 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in those parts of roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 within the length of road described in Column 2 of that Schedule to this Order.

2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order other than in the direction specified in Column 2 of that Schedule.

### **Exemptions**

3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle which is:-

a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes in an emergency; or

b)proceeding upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2022 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Alma Street, Ball Street and Green Lane)(Prohibition Of Driving And One Way Traffic) Order 2022.

Column 1	<u>Column 2</u>
Alma Street	From a point 50 metres east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Russell Street for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction.
Ball Street	From a point 48 metres north east of its junction with the northern kerb line of Green Lane for a distance of 85 metres in a north easterly direction.
