







White Irish Population in Sheffield





Nearly half of the White Irish community in Sheffield were born In the UK. A further 48% of Sheffield's White Irish community were born in Ireland.


















The proportion of White Irish 16 to 18 year olds not in education, employment

Disability

Nationally, 26% of the White Irish community have a limiting long-term health problem or disability compared with 18% of the population as a whole. This is linked, however, to the older age profile of the community. When comparing health problems and disability in different age groups, the proportions are broadly similar between the White Irish community and the population as a whole.

The Irish Community have a higher rate of contact with mental health services than white British and the 'white other' population. Sections of the Irish community in Sheffield are socially excluded and in need of support, including pensioners, the homeless and those with mental health and alcohol and drug dependency issues.
