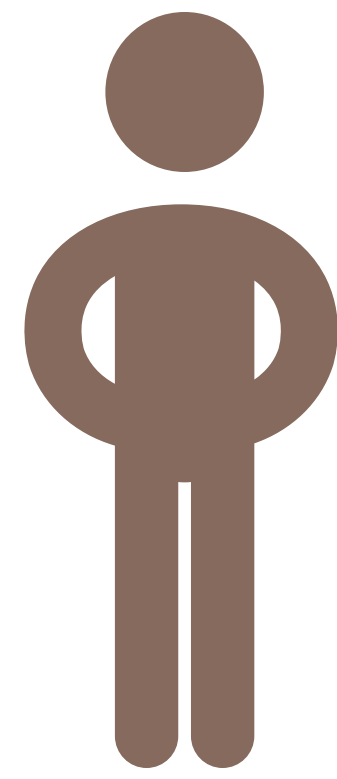

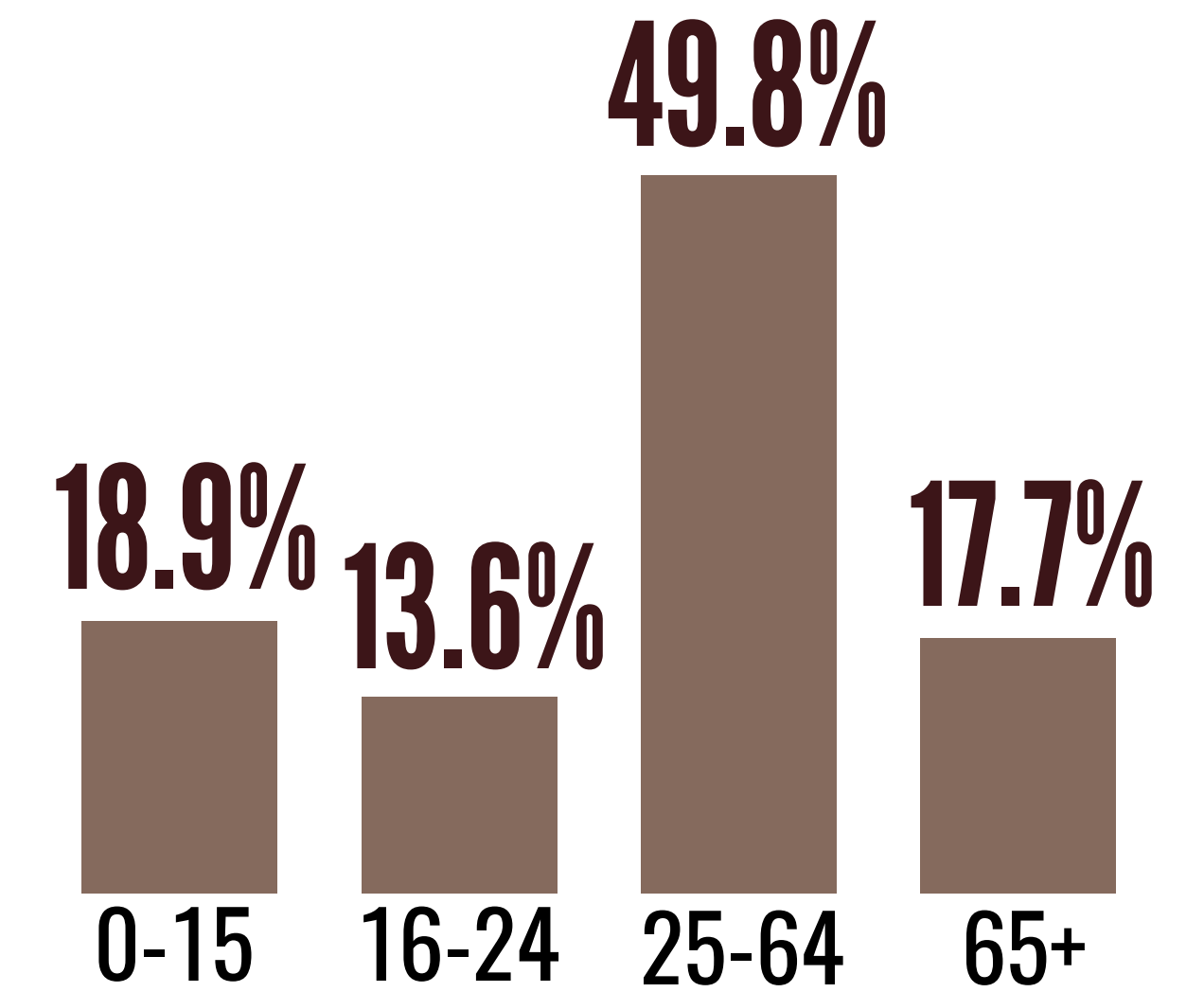

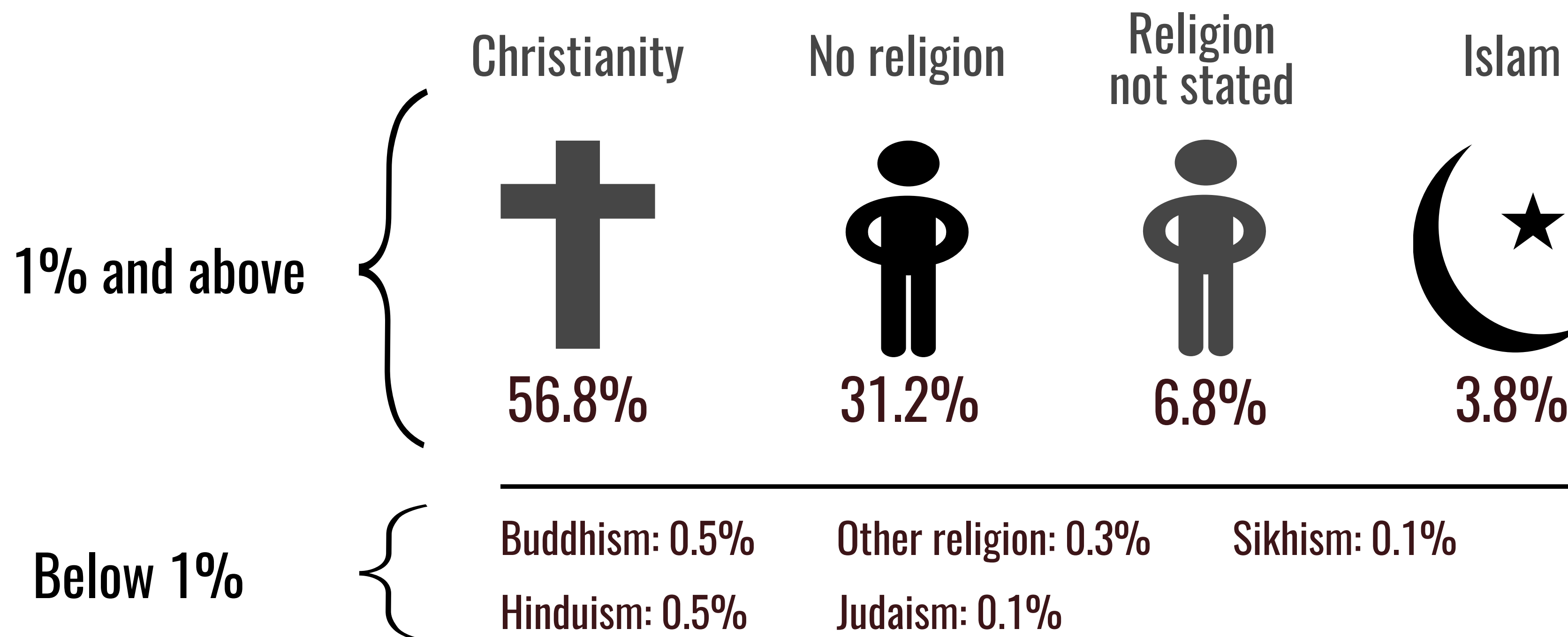

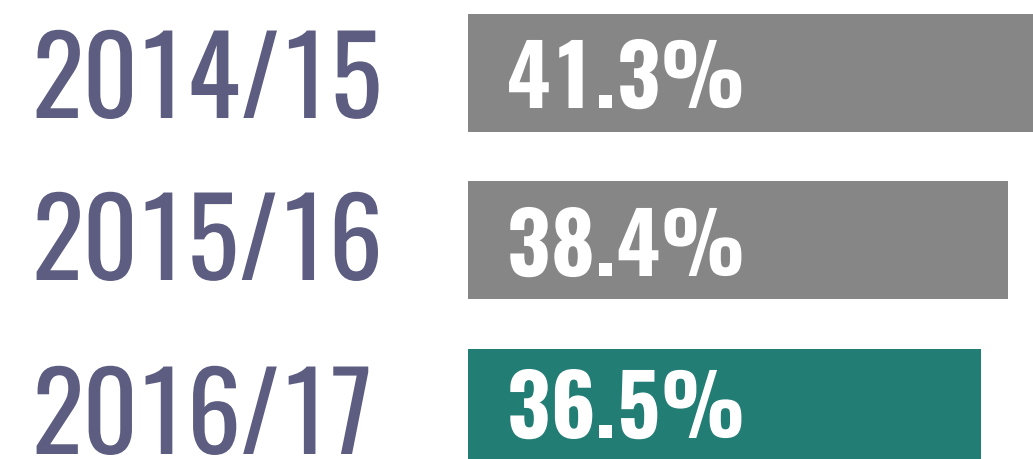

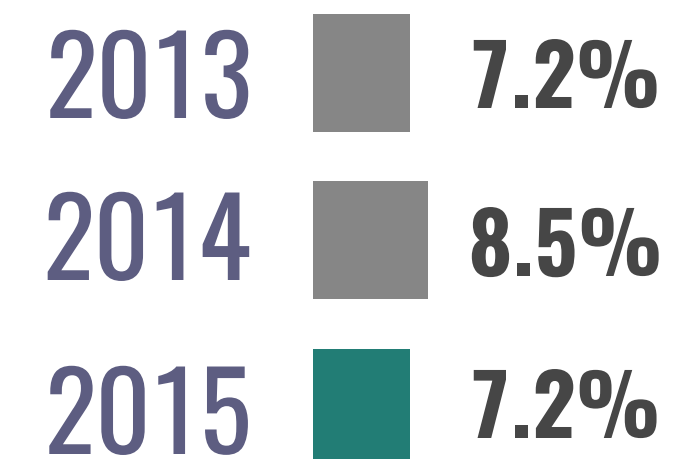

### Babies born weighing less than 2.5kg



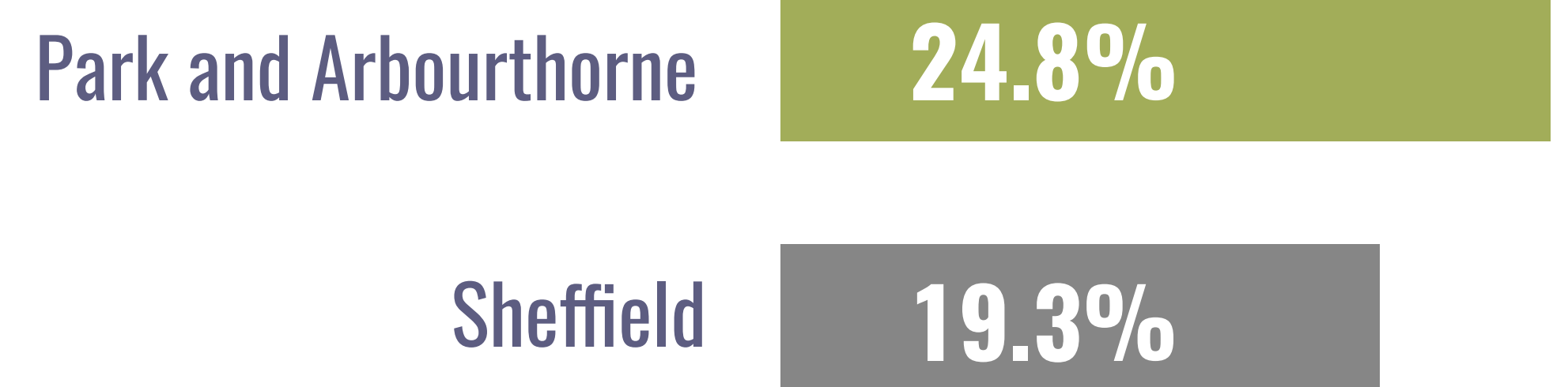

### Percentage of Children in Reception Year (4-5 years old) who are obese



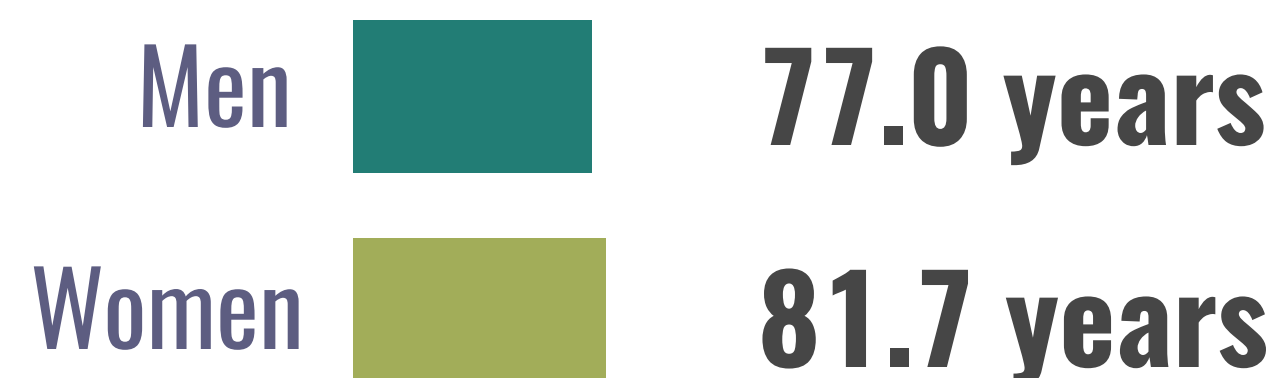
### Percentage of Children in Year 6 (10-11 years old) who are obese



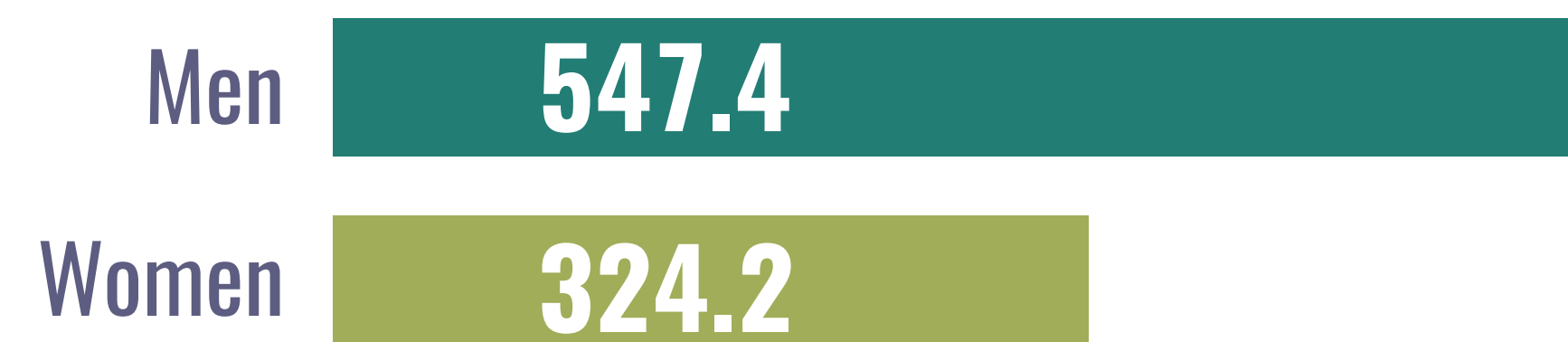

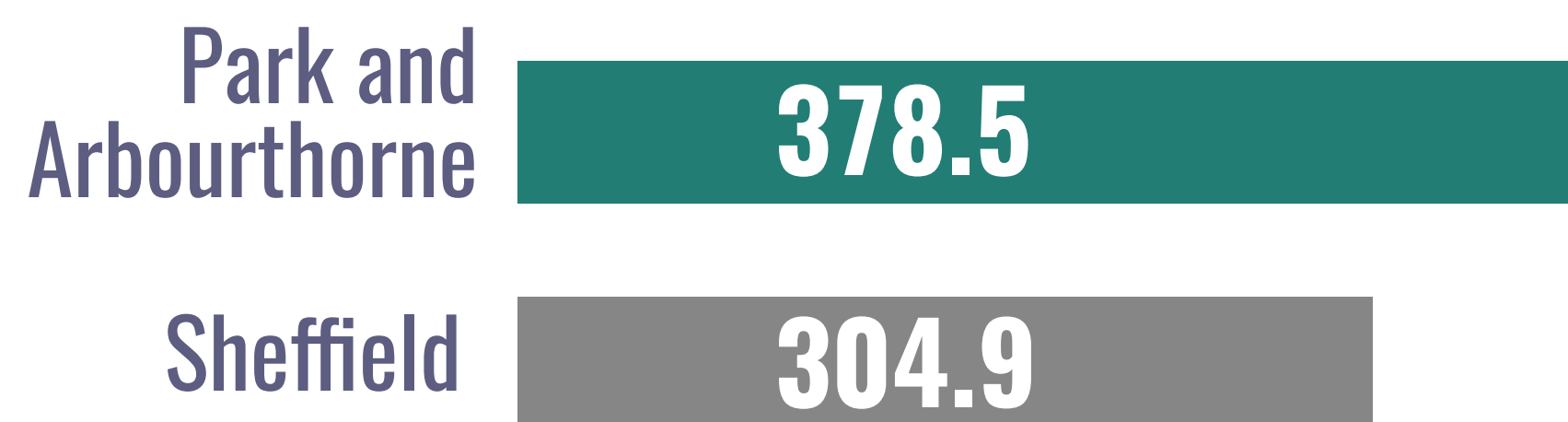

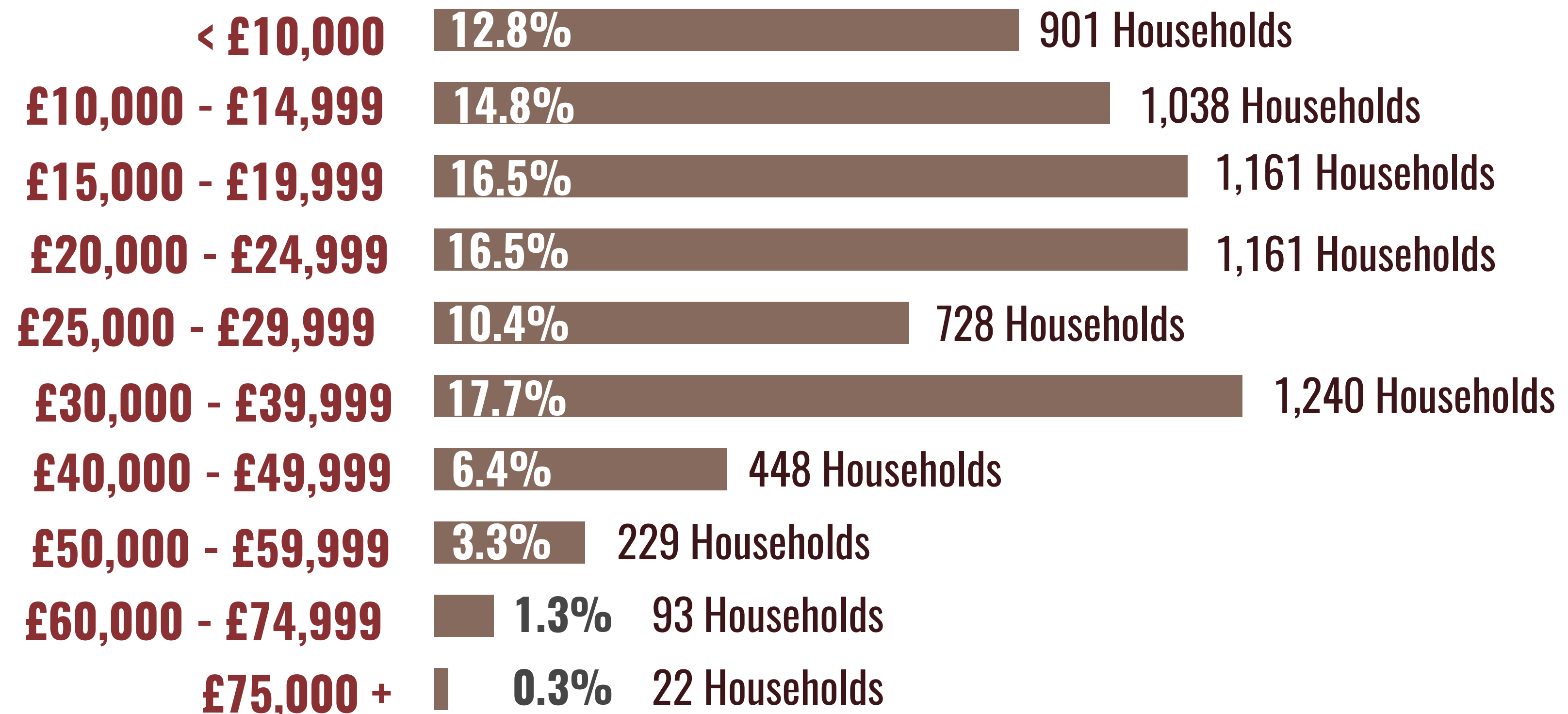
