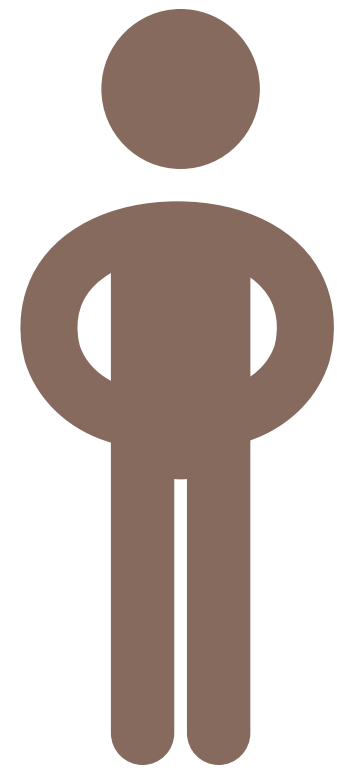

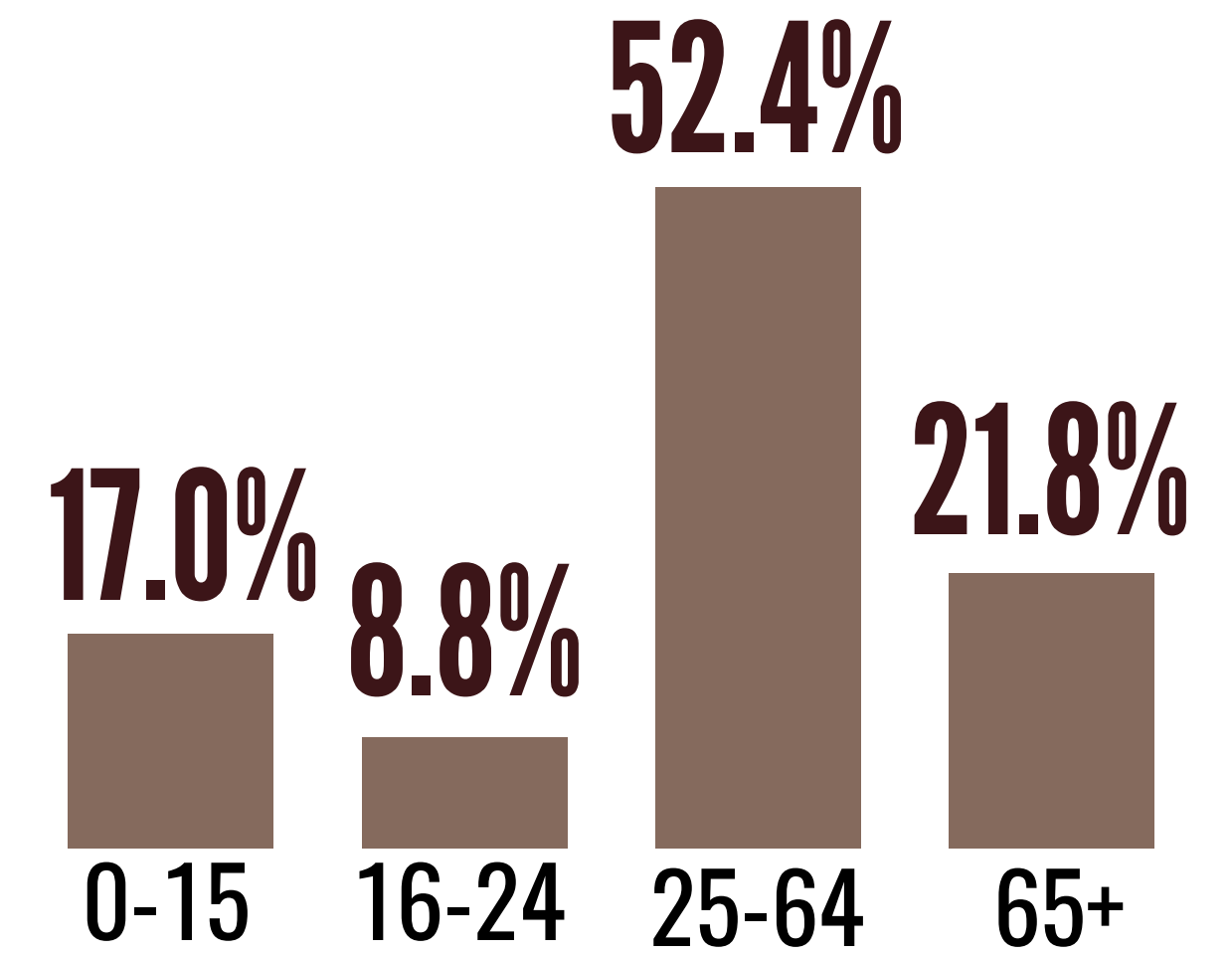

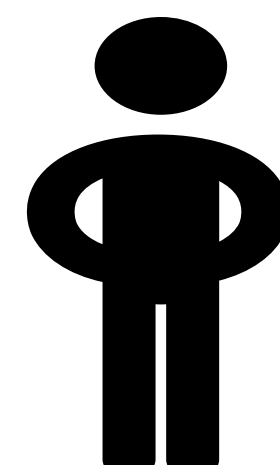

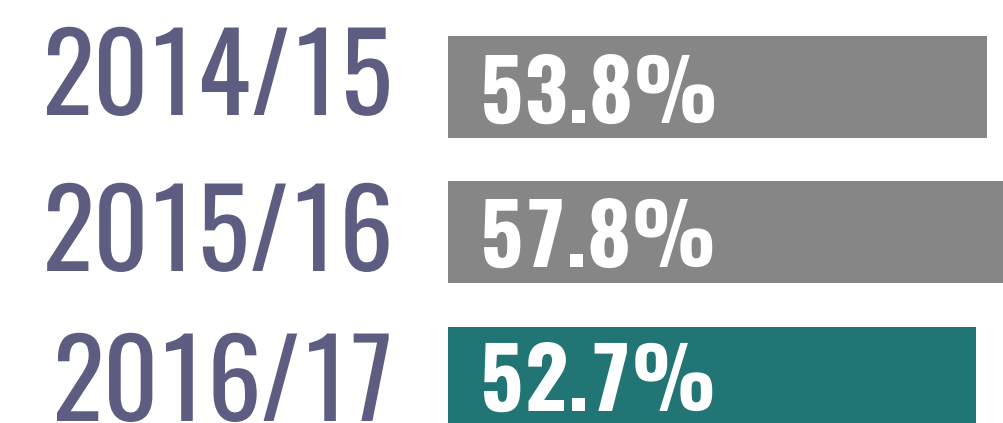

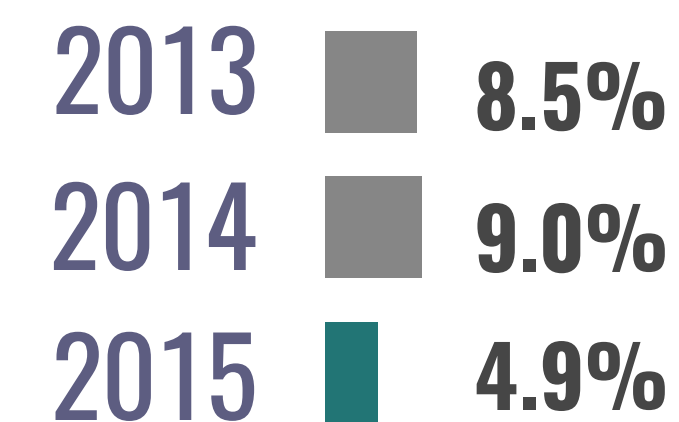

Babies born weighing less than 2.5kg



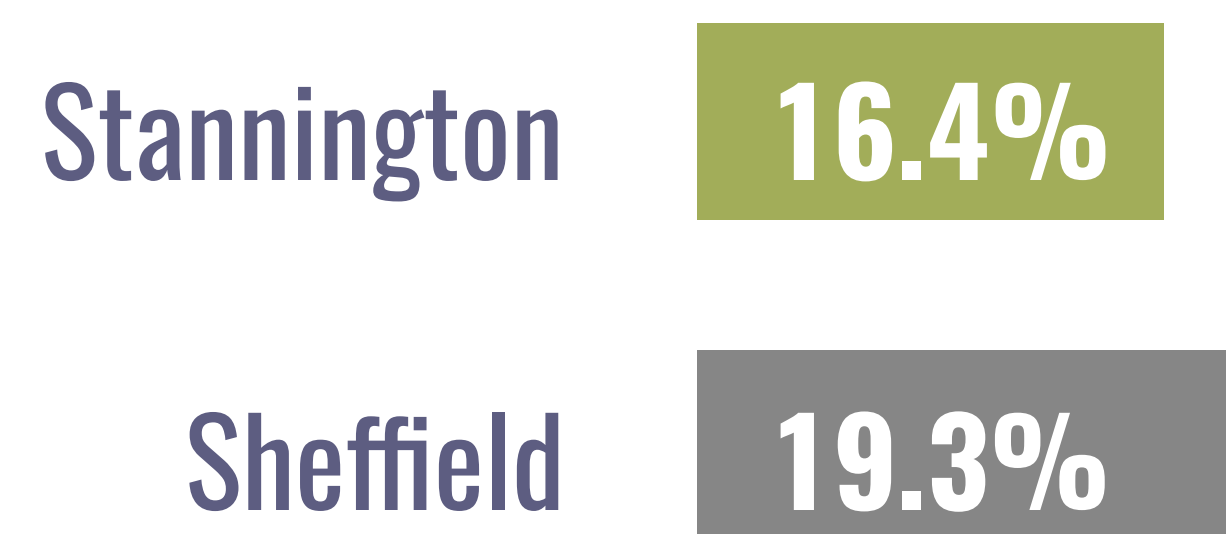

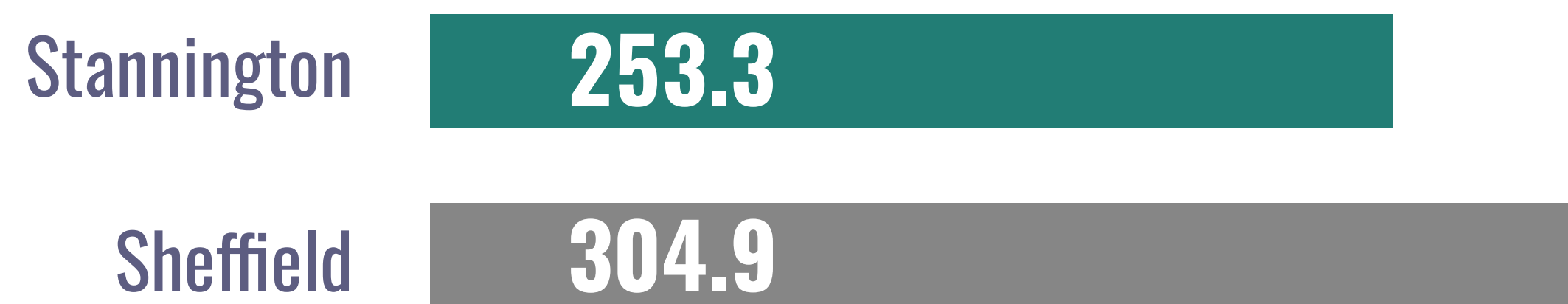

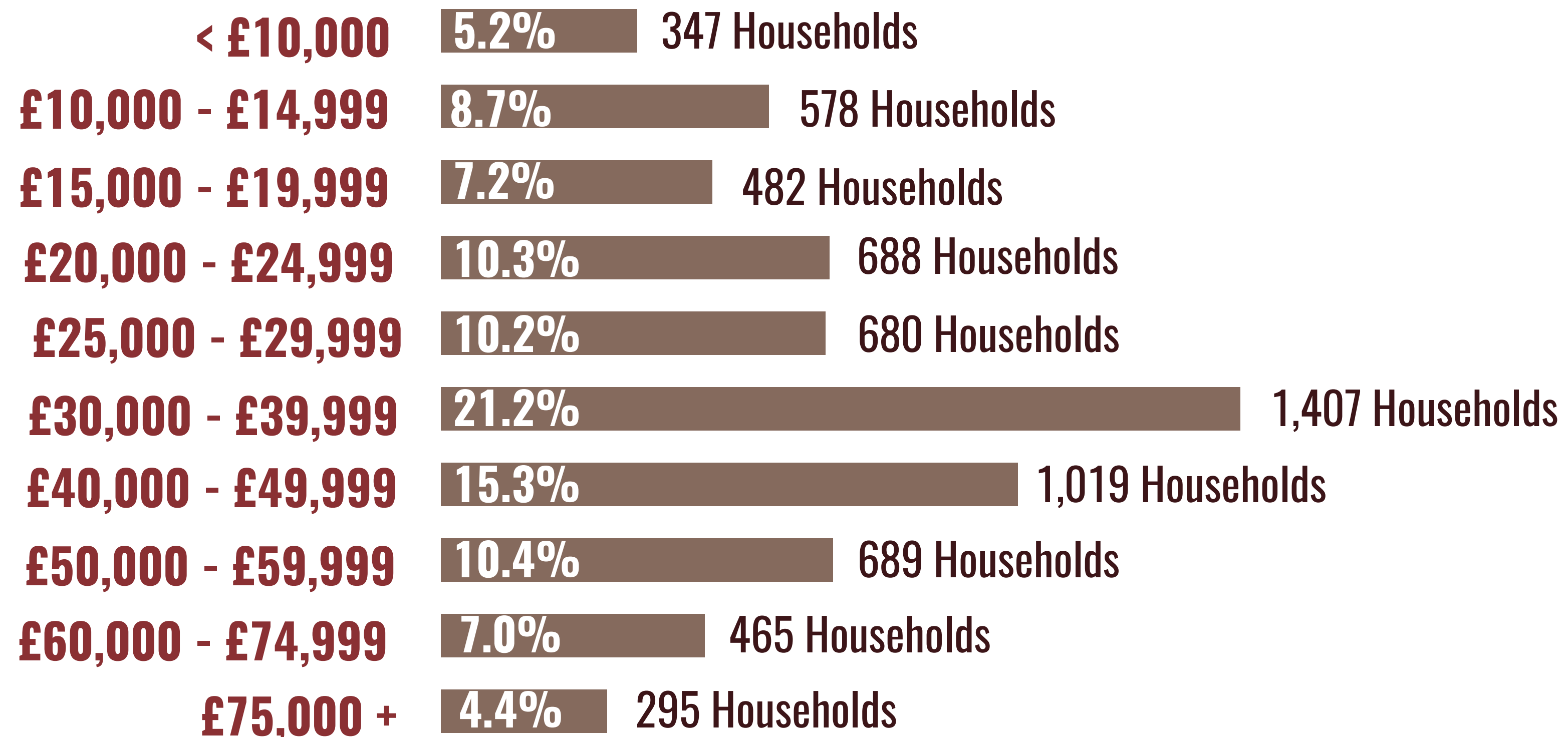

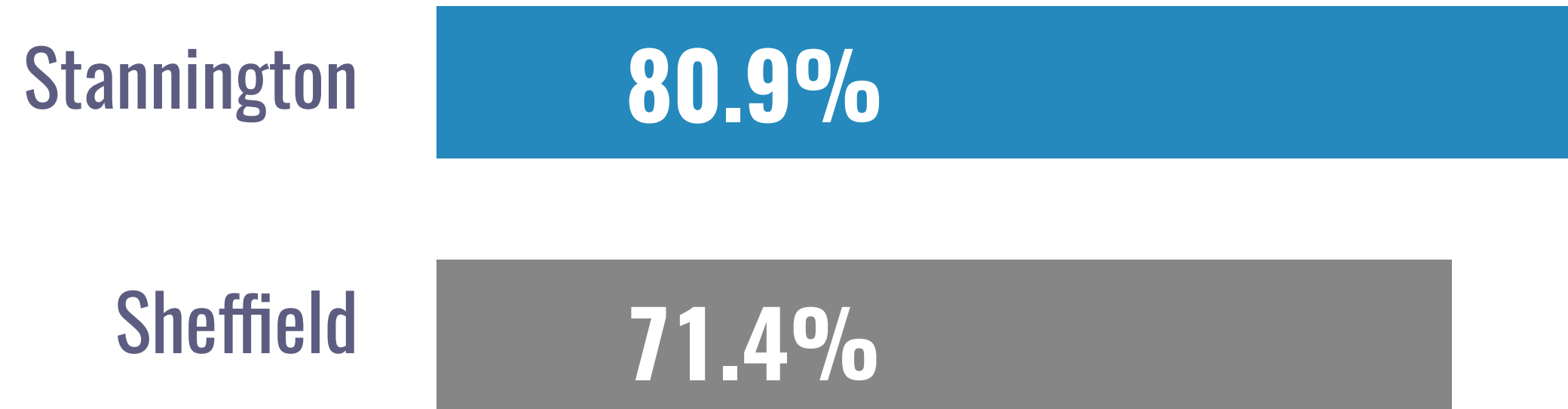

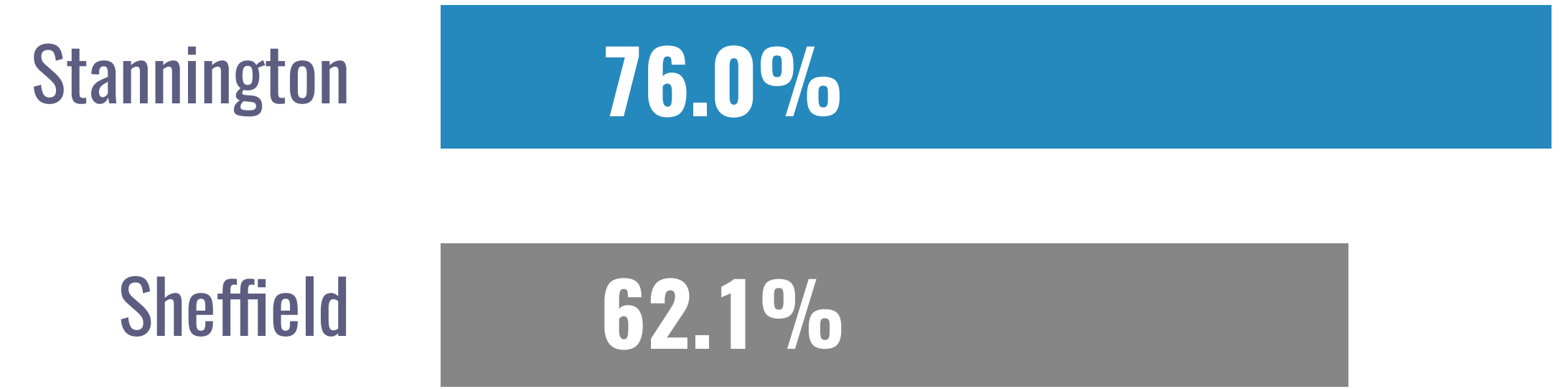

Percentage of pupils reaching the expected standard of reading (2016)

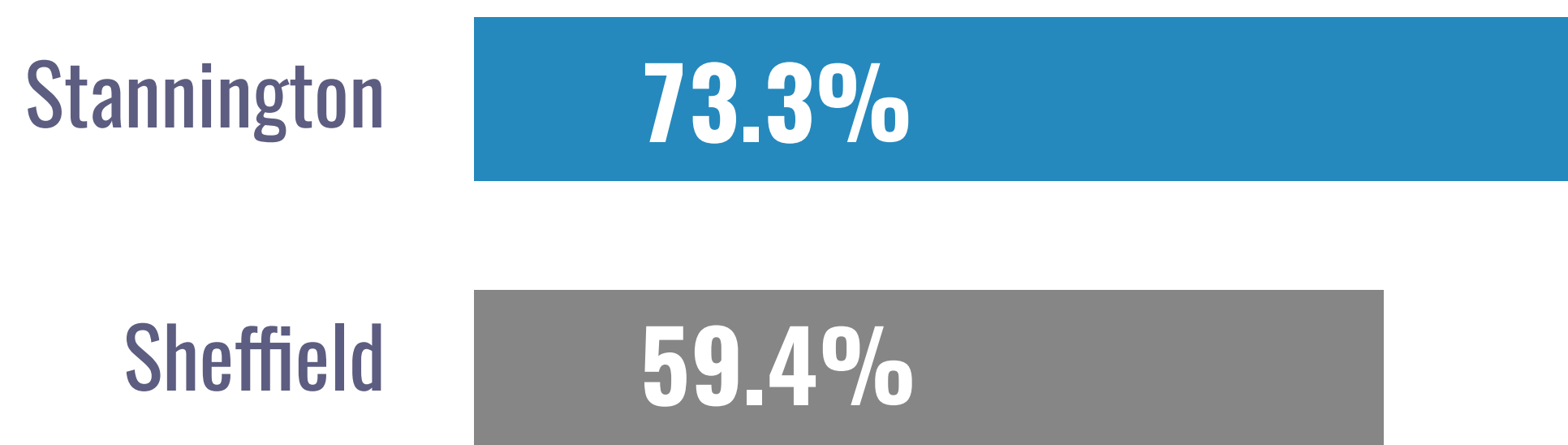

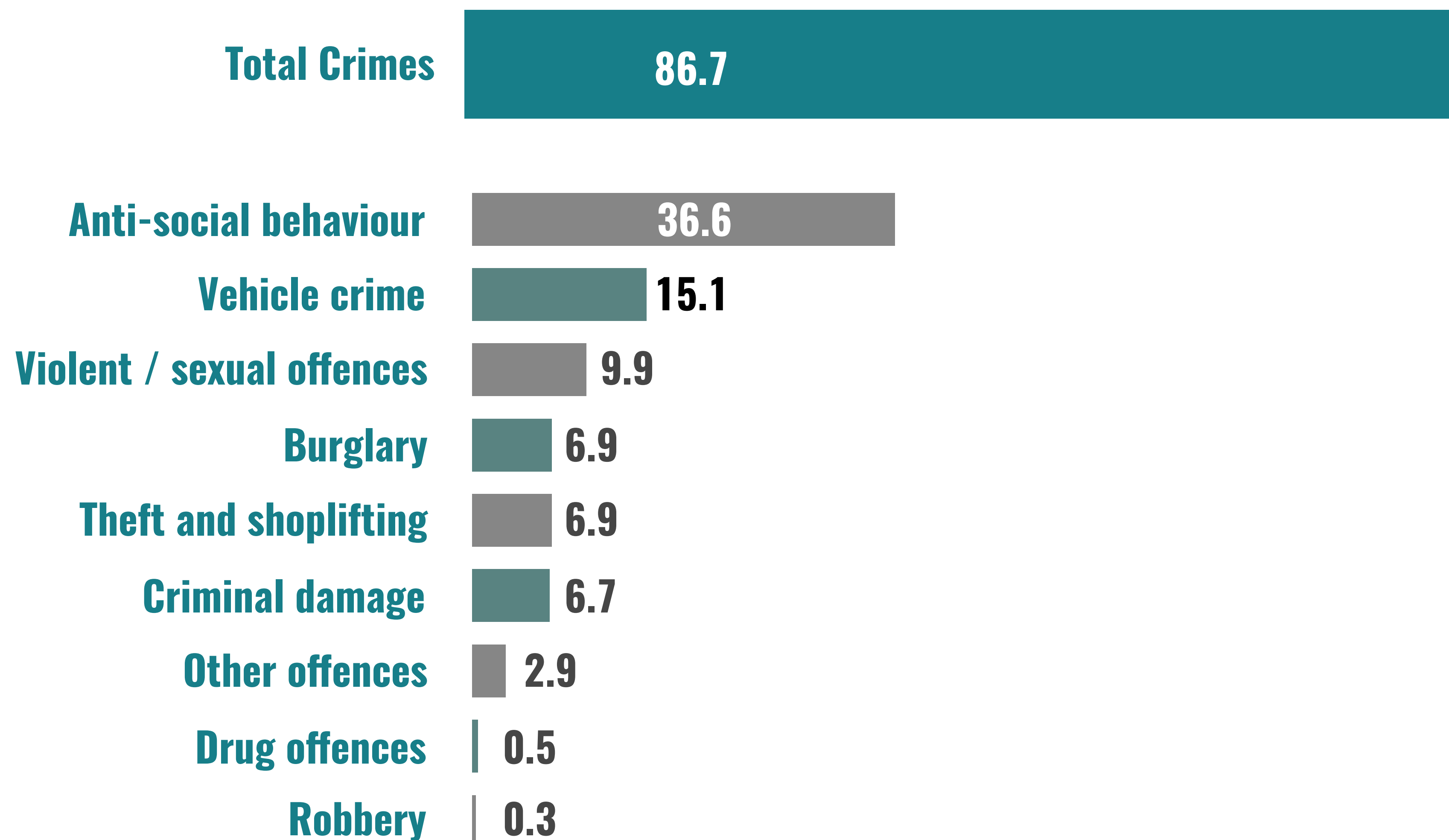
