The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the whole or on parts of Batemoor Close, Batemoor Drive, Batemoor Place, Batemoor Road, Bowshaw Avenue, Bowshaw Close, Bowshaw View, Dyche Close, Dyche Drive, Dyche Place, Dyche Road, Hazlebarrow Close, Hazlebarrow Court, Hazlebarrow Crescent, Hazlebarrow Drive, Hazlebarrow Grove, Hazlebarrow Road, Jordanthorpe Green, Jordanthorpe View, Lingfoot Avenue, Lingfoot Close, Lingfoot Crescent, Lingfoot Drive, Lingfoot Place, Ormond Close, Ormond Drive, Ormond Road, Ormond Way, Selly Oak Grove, Selly Oak Road, Whinacre Close, Whinacre Place, White Thorns Close, White Thorns Drive and White Thorns View.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 having given public notice in accordance with subsection (2) of that section and schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when use in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the day of and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Batemoor) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2022.
