<u>THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL</u> (MONA ROAD, CROOKES, SHEFFIELD) (EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 9 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of October, 2022 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Mona Road, Crookes, Sheffield)(Experimental Traffic)(One Way Traffic) Order 2022.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order other than in the direction specified in Column 2 of that Schedule.

Exemptions

- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle which is:
 - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes in an emergency; or
 - b) proceeding upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.
