- Prohibition of Motor Vehicles on part of Glover Road;

And remove:

- No loading/unloading 7.30am to 6.30pm on parts of Broadfield Road and Saxon Road; and
- Prohibition of Driving on Glover Road.

432A Glover Road (Heeley)

The north eastern termination:

(i) The whole.

The south east side:

(i) From a point 117 metres north east of the eastern kerb line of Staveley Road to its junction with the north eastern termination. including the whole of the south eastern turning area.

The south western termination:

- (i) The whole
- b) In Schedule 1.01C thereto there were deleted the item '872A Staveley Road Both sides (i)'.

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

3. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that part of Glover Road – between a point 22 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of London Road for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction.

Exemptions

4. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that part of Glover Road – between a point 22 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of London Road for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction.

Revocations

- 5. The South Yorkshire County Council (Various Roads at Highfield)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1978 (as amended) shall have effect as though in Schedule 2 the item 'Glover Road' was deleted.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th day of November 2022, and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Broadfield Road and Glover Road)(Prohibition of Driving and Prohibited Turns) Order 2022 (Amendment No.1) 2022.
