PUBLIC NOTICE
BRIDGE HILL, OUGHTIBRIDGE - PROPOSED SPEED HUMP

Notice is hereby given that Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 90C of the Act, intends to install a road hump as below:

- **Bridge Hill** - 1 Kerb to Kerb flat top road hump, 75mm high with an 11 metres long plateau with 1.5m ramps at its junction with Orchard Street/Low Road, Oughtibridge.

These measures are aimed at controlling speed and improving safety for all road users especially pedal cycles and motorcycles at this junction.
