

## Dementia Training- Direct Carers

Sheffield City Councils Adults Care commissioning team have developed a 'Dementia Learning Pathway'. The pathway has been developed to ensure that people can live well with Dementia, by improving the Health & Social Care workforce knowledge and skills, due to the increased levels of acuity in Dementia care.

The training developed in collaboration with industry experts by experience, will focus more on 'how' to deliver services to deliver the best possible outcomes for people, as opposed to 'what' the disease is.

The Dementia Learning Pathway can be seen below. This aims to give an overview of each of the stages staff will look to complete to support development and content of learning that will be covered within each stage.
