
## Access Land alongside Stubbing Lane







This is an area of young woodland and heathland next to an area of land that is currently in use as a golf course. The part of the site that is in use as a golf course it is out of bounds to walkers who must keep to the Public Footpath running through the middle of site. The site generally contains only very gentle gradients and most of the paths are quite level although not all of them are surfaced with stone.
