- An Exemption for Cyclists on the One Way Traffic restriction on Pond Hill;

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Sheffield City Council (Controlled Zone) (Prohibition And Restriction Of Waiting And One Way Traffic (Consolidation) Order 1987 (as amended ) shall have effect as though:
  - a) For Article 9C in Part III ONE-WAY TRAFFIC thereto there was substituted the following item:-
    - 9C. Nothing in Article 8 of this Order shall apply to a pedal cycle when being used in the sections of Bailey Lane, Bailey Street, Balm Green, Barker's Pool, Favell Road, Gell Street, Holland Street, Holly Street, Hounsfield Road, Leavy Greave Road (east), Orange Street, Pinfold Street, Pond Hill, Portobello Street, Trippet Lane, Victoria Street, specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2023 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Controlled Zone) (Prohibition And Restriction Of Waiting And One Way Traffic (Consolidation) Order 1987 (Amendment No.55) Order 2023.
