STATEMENT OF REASONS

Howard Street and Howard Street Access Road – it is proposed to change the description of the current Pedestrian and Cycle Zone area to include Howard Street Access Road that leads to Hallam University Owen Building. The restriction will have an exemption for disabled persons vehicles that are gaining access to the disabled persons parking places on Howard Street Access Road and for vehicles loading and unloading at premises adjacent to the roads.


- (i) Between Howard Street, Howard Square and the south eastern building line of the Owen Building.
