Background

We manage and maintain 38,000 council homes in Sheffield as part of Sheffield City Council, providing a range of housing-related services to tenants and around 2,300 leaseholders. We provide statutory and regulatory functions to all tenants, including the city's private rented sector. We work closely with tenant and leaseholder groups to shape service delivery, thus shaping change and ensuring ongoing satisfaction with the service.
