Duties & Responsibilities

Senior Technician & Science Technician:

- Making up solutions;
- Assembling apparatus;
- Delivering equipment and paperwork to the laboratory;
- Collecting, checking and returning equipment to stores;
- Taking care of laboratory equipment and apparatus including routine checks;
- Carrying out minor maintenance and notifying Senior Technician of need for major repair of equipment;
- Stocktaking chemicals and equipment;
- Caring for the department's plants;
- Trialling practical activities;
- Assessing risks for technician activities;
- Understanding, complying and keeping up-to-date with Health & Safety requirements;
- Setting up demonstrations including data loggers;
- Keeping work place, prep room, laboratories and storerooms tidy

In addition to the above, the Senior Technician will also be required to:

- Manage stock;
- Obtain materials by local purchase;
- Place orders and check deliveries/invoices;
- Keep financial records;
- Manage, monitor and supervise the performance of the other technicians;
- Keep up-to-date with Health and Safety requirements, ensuring that they are implemented within school, and that technicians are suitably trained;
- Arrange for major maintenance and repair of equipment
- Maintain up-to-date technicians notes for all standard experiments in Science
- File requisition sheets for 5 years with risk assessments
- Undertake flammable stock take for fire officer in school
- Liaise with premises for pressure vessel and fume cupboard checks and laboratory repairs e.g. gas taps & sinks, leaks & floods

Additional Specific Responsibilities:

In consultation with the post holder, the Headteacher/Line Manager may request a person to take on any additional duties or responsibilities as the school develops and/or the need arises.
