Appendix

Definitions

Funded Early Learning (FEL) - This is the 15 funded hours for all 3 and 4 year olds and disadvantaged 2 year olds. Children are eligible the term after their 3rd birthday, or 2nd birthday if they are eligible.

Extended Funded Entitlement (EFE) – This is the extra 15 funded hours working families are entitled to. This will include the new entitlement for 2 year olds from April 2024 and 9 months to 1 year olds from September 2024.

Entitlements Expansion (EE) - This is the new initiative for working families. The expansion is to be introduced in 3 phases;

- Phase 1: April 2024 15 hours of childcare over 38 weeks of the year made available to eligible parents of two-year-olds.
- Phase 2: September 2024 15 hours of childcare over 38 weeks of the year made available to eligible parents of 9-month to 36-montholds.
- Phase 3: September 2025 30 hours of childcare over 38 weeks of the year made available to eligible parents of 9-month to 36-montholds.



This information is therefore incomplete and has meant we have used 2023 School Census as it gives us a more complete picture.



Take-up of 2 year old FEL is very varied in Planning Area 4. The general trend has been an increase in take in all areas except the East which has remained constant. The South shows a particularly low take-up. There are 14 LSOAs of concern, 10 of which are in the South. There are sufficient places in the East and North but in not in the South and West.

Take-up has been consistent in the North and West, while it has slightly increased in the South and East. Despite the increase the South has a low take-up. There are 33 LSOAs of concern. Unlike the 2 year olds these are not concentrated in the South but spread across the 4 sub-areas. There are sufficient FEL places in the East and West but not in the North and South.



Map 1: Eligible 2 Year Olds not Taking-up FEL


Eligible Two Year Olds Not Taking-up a FEL Place in Planning Area 4 - Spring 2023


Map 2: All 3 and 4 Year Olds not Taking-up FEL or Early Education

All Three and Four Year Olds Not Taking-up FEL in Planning Area 4 - Spring 2023




Map 3: EFE Take-up


Number of Children Taking-up EFE in Planning Area 4 - Spring 2023
