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Definitions

Funded Early Learning (FEL) - This is the 15 funded hours for all 3 and 4 year olds and disadvantaged 2 year olds. Children are eligible the term after their 3rd birthday, or 2nd birthday if they are eligible.

Extended Funded Entitlement (EFE) – This is the extra 15 funded hours working families are entitled to. This will include the new entitlement for 2 year olds from April 2024 and 9 months to 1 year olds from September 2024.

Entitlements Expansion (EE) – This is the new initiative for working families. The expansion is to be introduced in 3 phases;

- Phase 1: April 2024 - 15 hours of childcare over 38 weeks of the year made available to eligible parents of two-year-olds.
- Phase 2: September 2024 - 15 hours of childcare over 38 weeks of the year made available to eligible parents of 9-month to 36-month-olds.
- Phase 3: September 2025 - 30 hours of childcare over 38 weeks of the year made available to eligible parents of 9-month to 36-month-olds

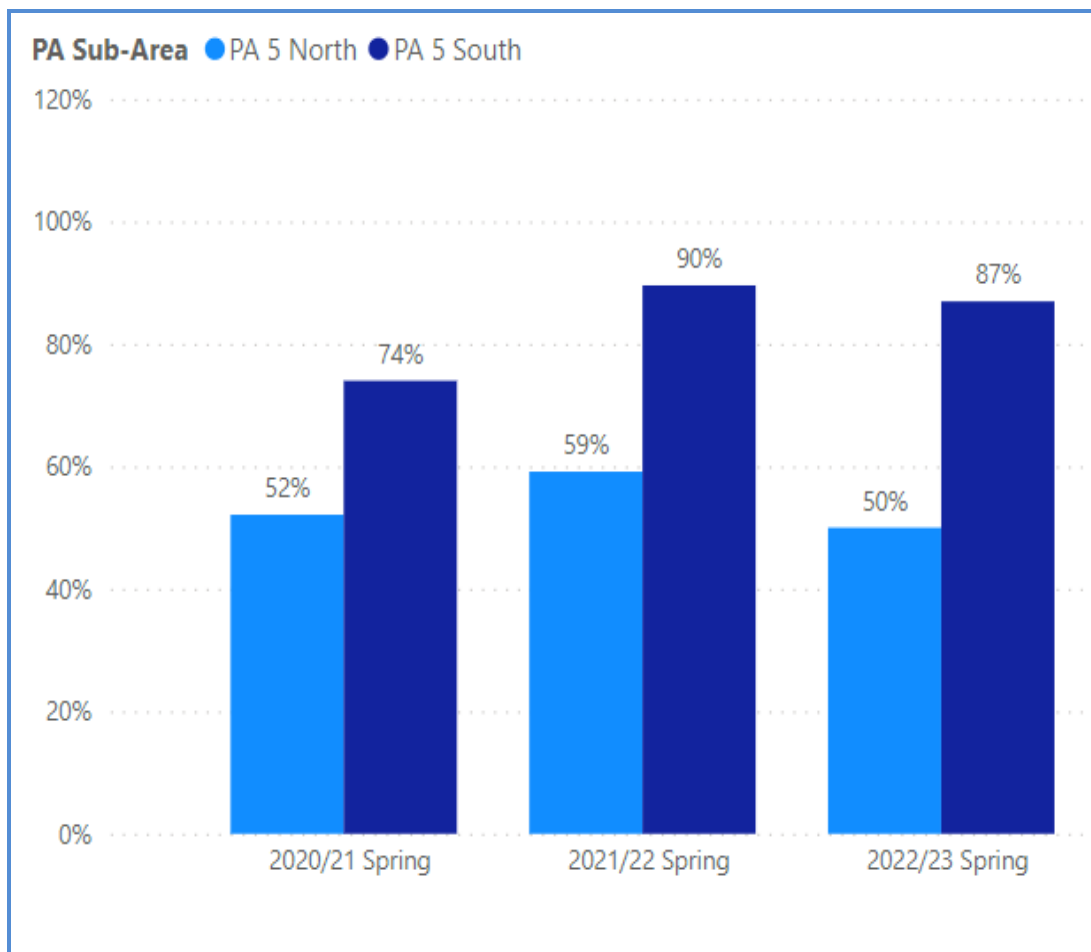

Wraparound Data – January School Census 2023. Although several surveys have been carried out to collect more up to date data, there has been a mixed response and only about 50% schools have responded. This information is therefore incomplete and has meant we have used 2023 School Census as it gives us a more complete picture.

Planning Area 5 - FEL Performance Profile for 2 Year Olds – Spring 2023



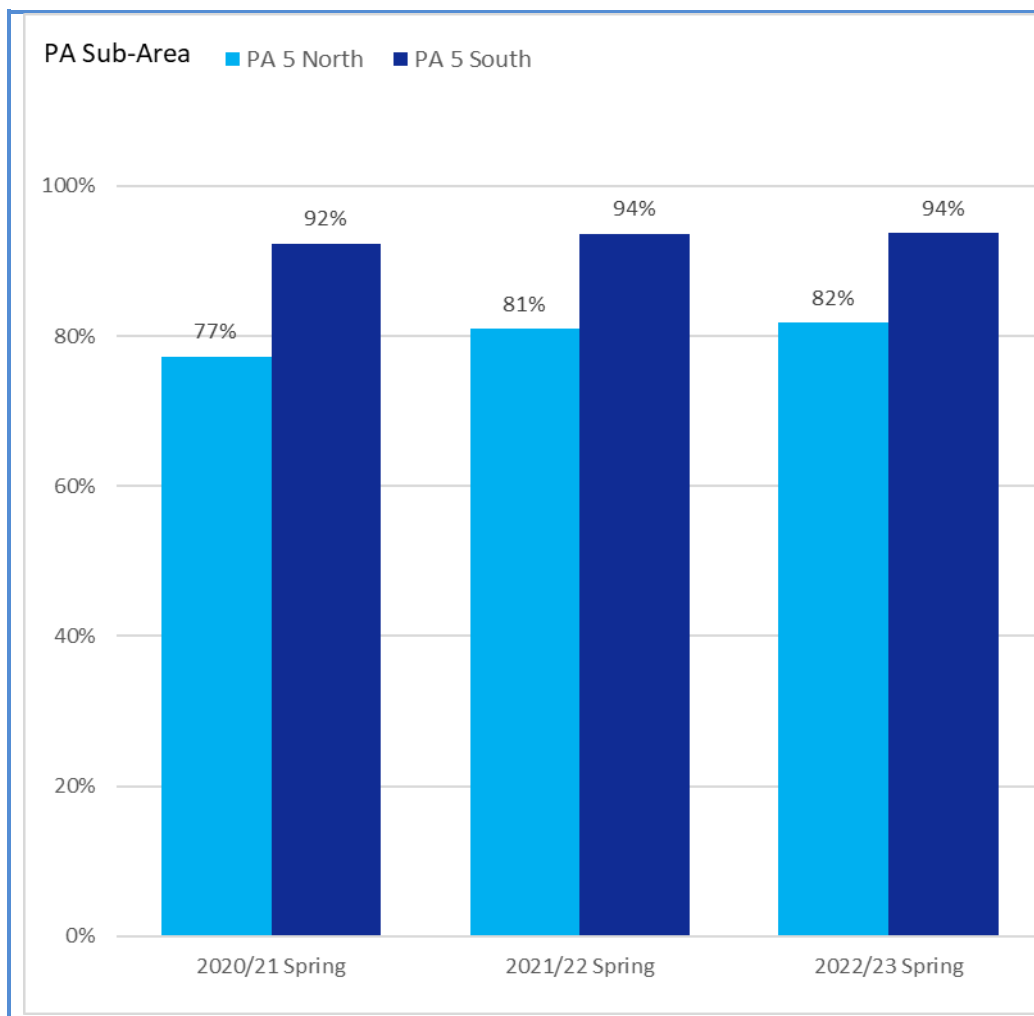

The 2 areas of Planning Area 5 are very different in terms of 2 year old FEL take-up. The North has a low take-up while the South's take-up is very high. 11 of the LSOAs are of concern, with more than 5 eligible children not taking up a place. The majority of these are in the North. Neither sub-area has sufficient places for the eligible population.

The take-up rate in the South has been fairly consistent, whilst in the North it shows a slight upward trend, although it is still low overall. There are 19 LSOAs that have more than 5 eligible children not taking up FEL and are therefore classed as areas of concern. These are fairly evenly spread between the North and the South, however the LSOAs with the greatest number not taking up tend to be in the North. There are generally sufficient places in the North, however, this is not the case in the South.

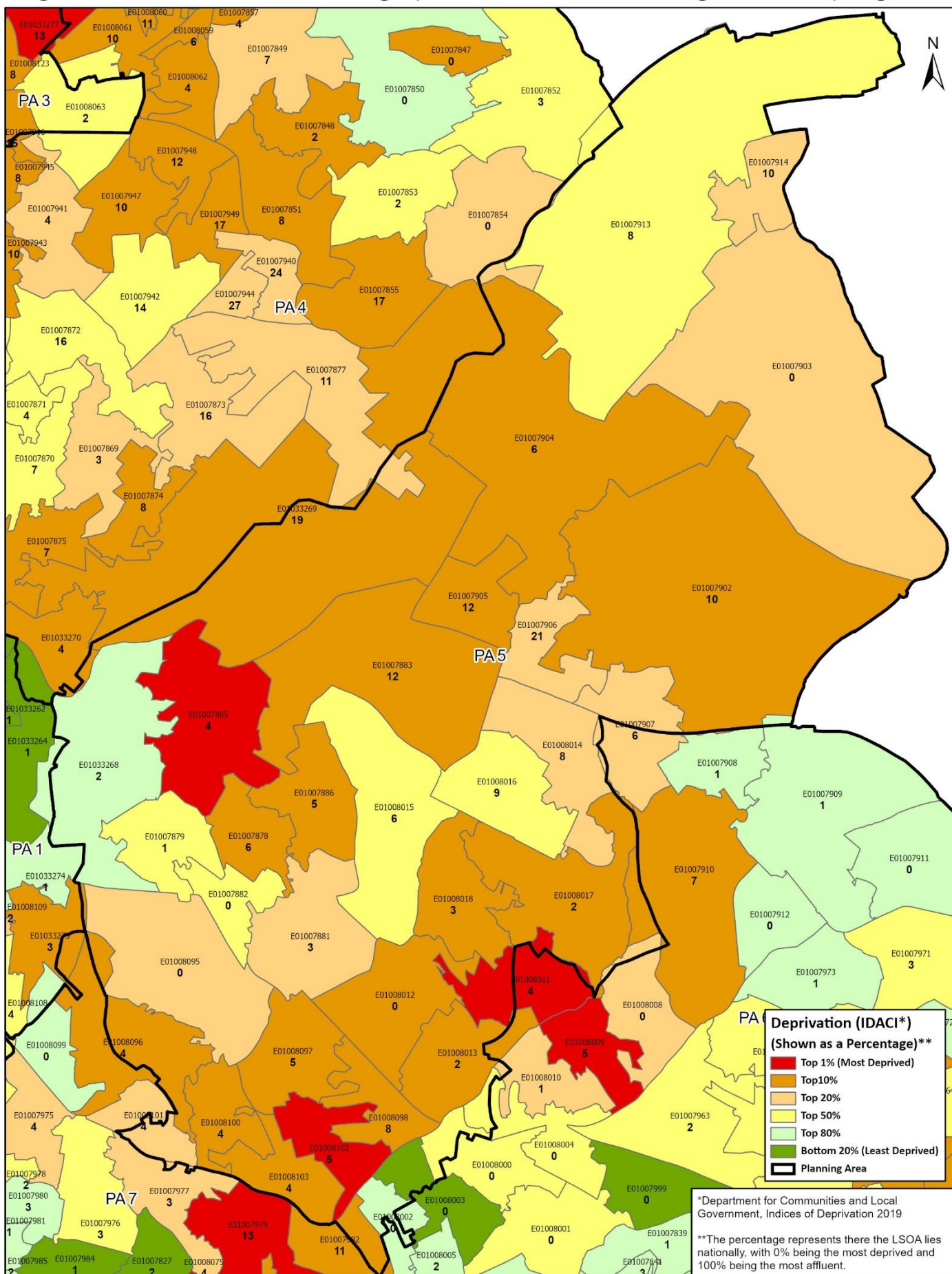

The data above may give some indication on the level of demand. It is also expected the greatest demand for wraparound care will come from working parents.

Eligible Two Year Olds Not Taking-up a FEL Place in Planning Area 5 - Spring 2023

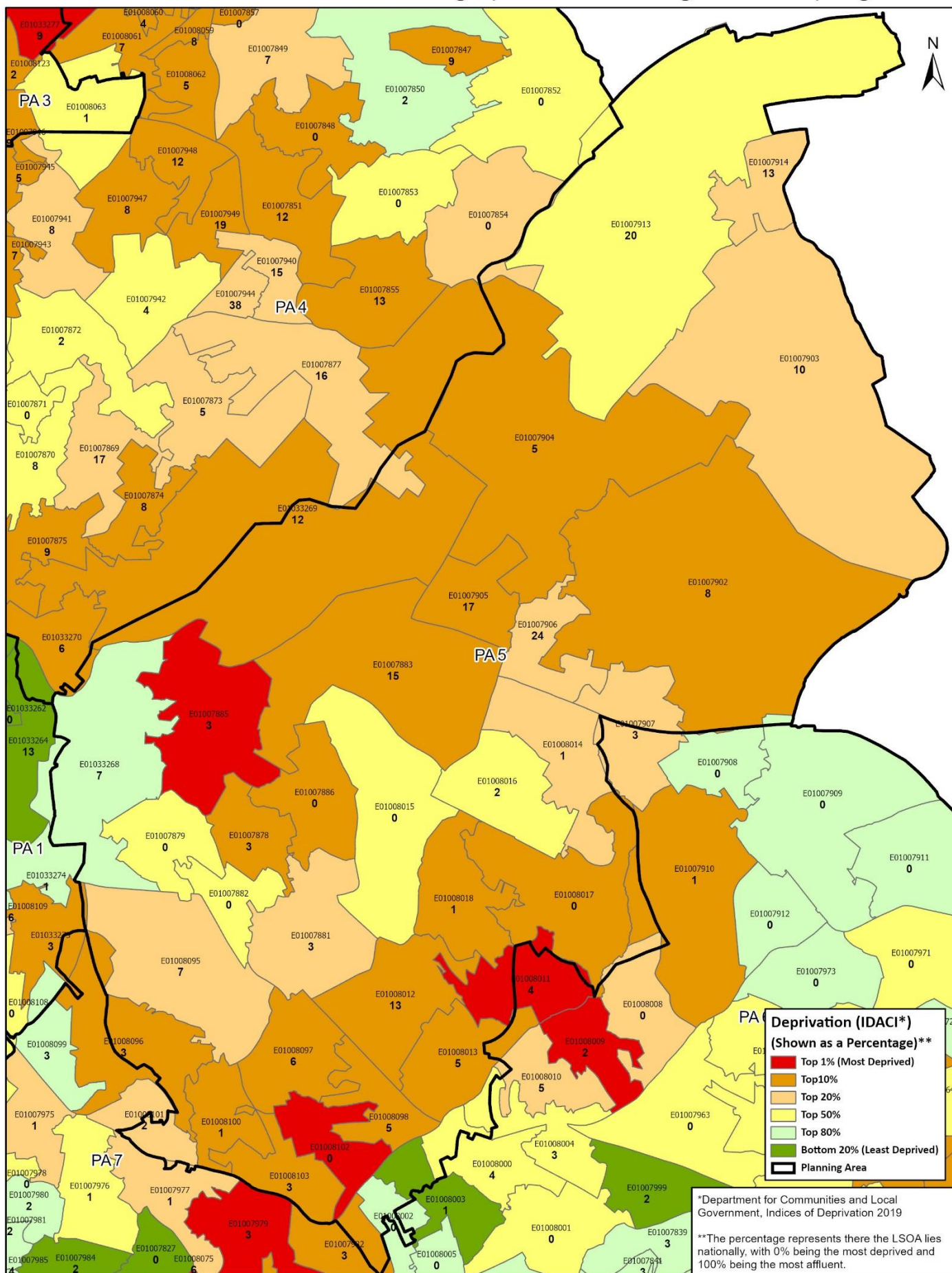


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Map 2: All 3 and 4 Year Olds not Taking-up FEL or Early Education

All Three and Four Year Olds Not Taking-up FEL in Planning Area 5 - Spring 2023

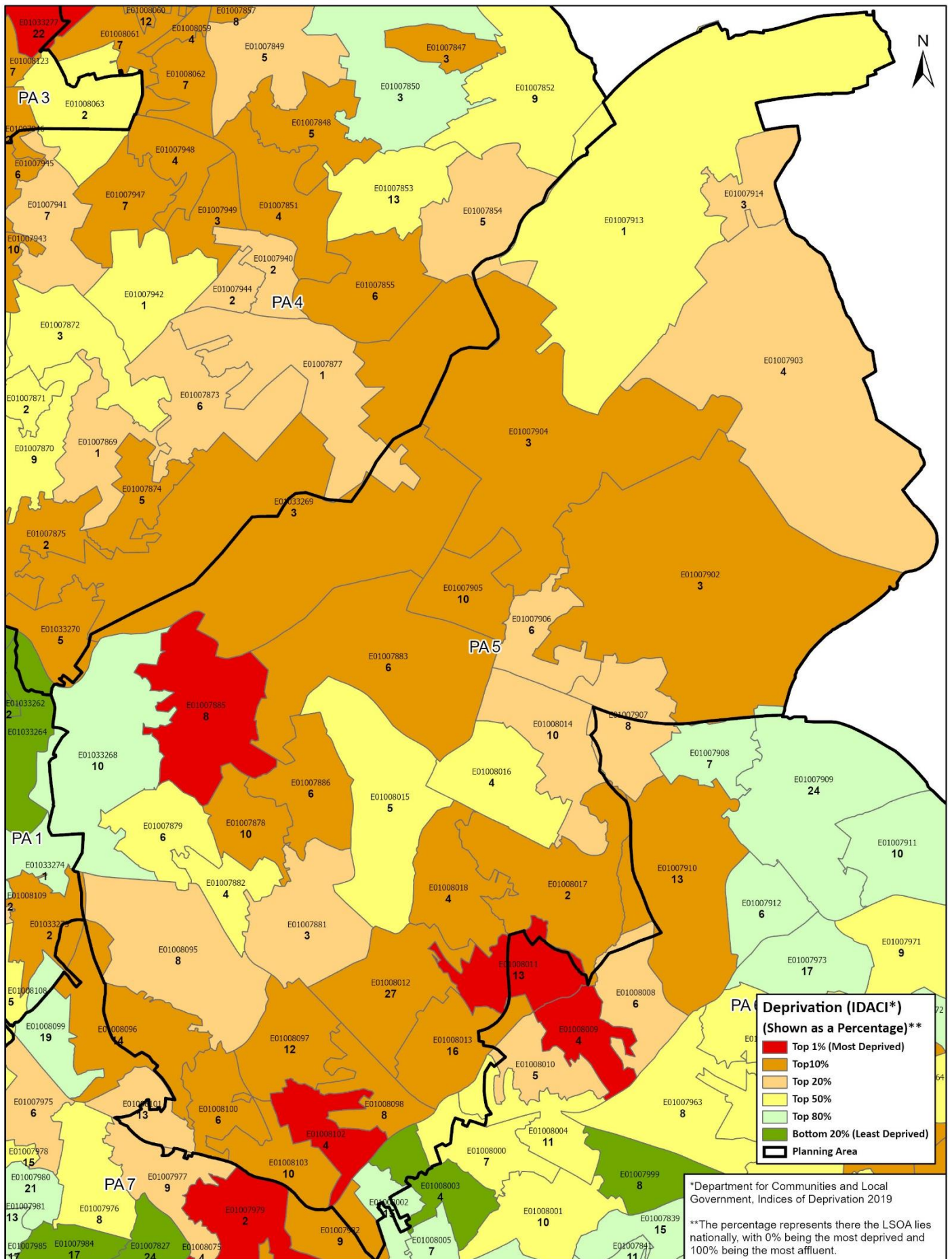

Number of Children Taking-up EFE in Planning Area 5 - Spring 2023

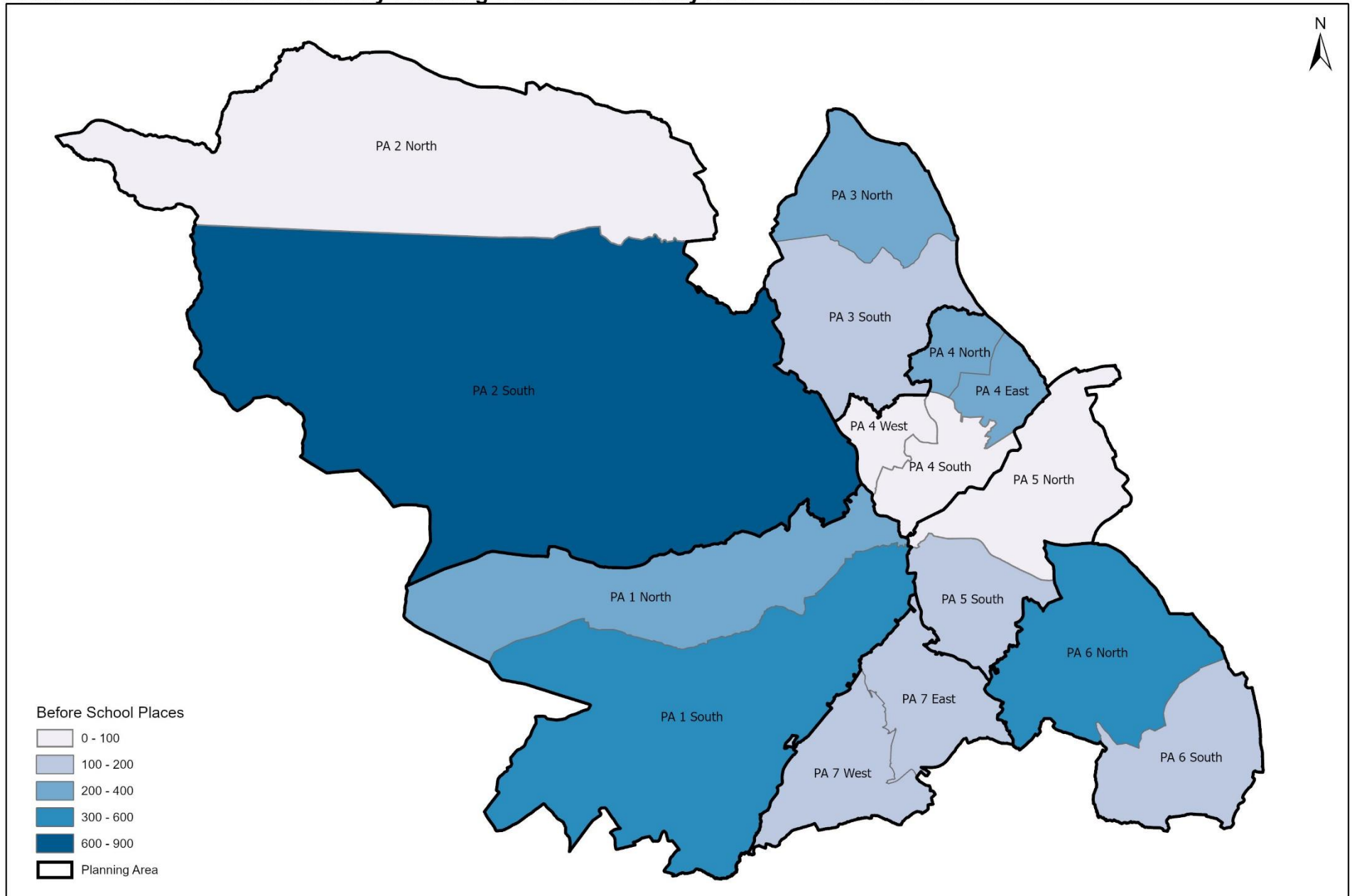

Number of Before School Places by Planning Sub-Area - January 2023 School Census

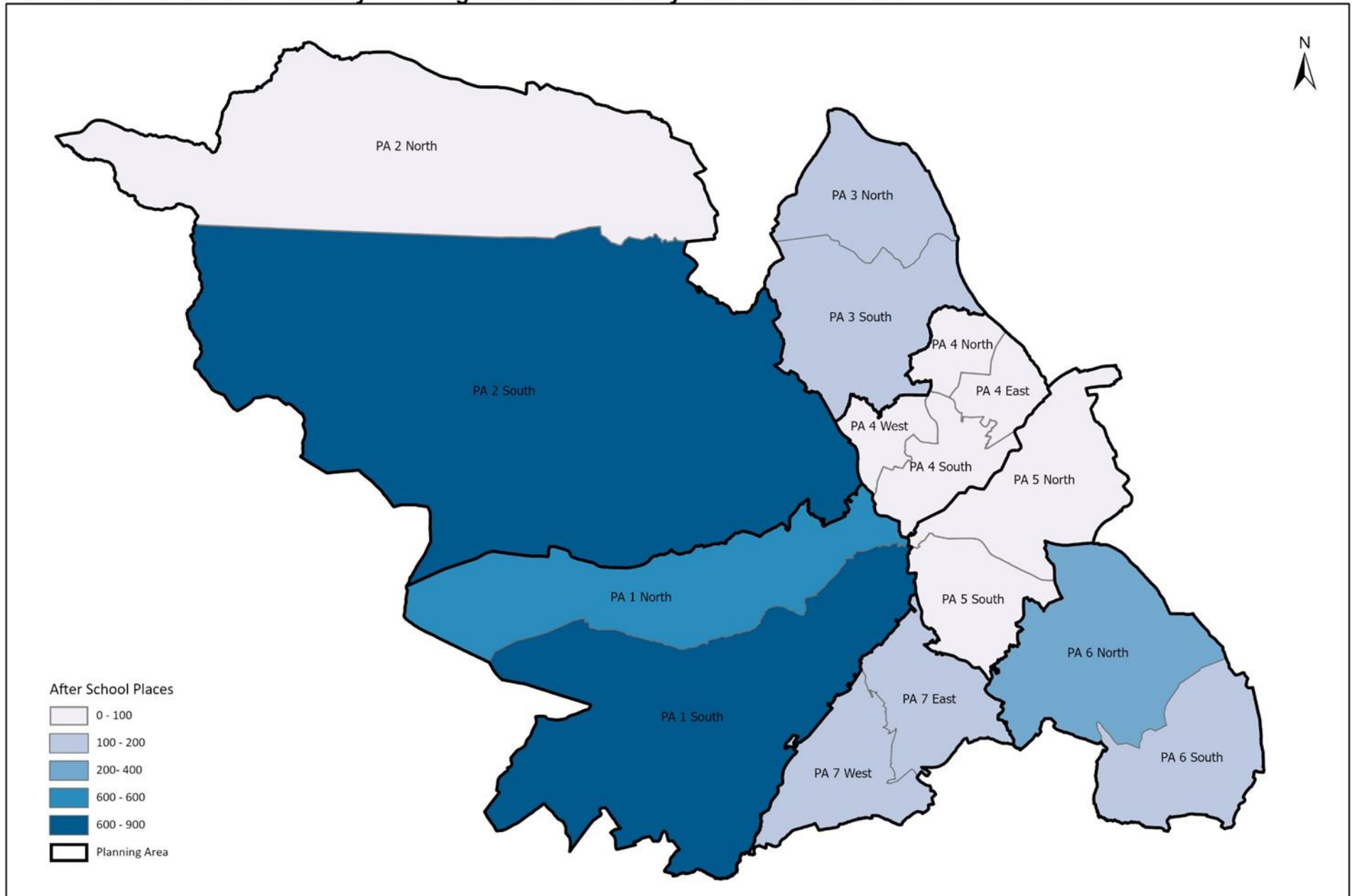


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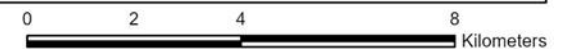
