STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Authority's reasons for proposing to make the above named Order(s) are as follows:-

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- Improving the amenities of the area

Explanatory Note:-

Avenue Road - the proposed prohibition of vehicles restriction covers the area currently used as a temporary Parklet for the use of the community. The Order is required to prohibit vehicles from entering this area permanently so the Parklet can be continued to be used. The area will be closed by physical means.

Part I

The Sheffield City Council acting as the Local Traffic Authority in exercise of its powers conferred by Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3, 4, 19, 65(1), 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and Section 21 and Schedules 1 and 2 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 as amended and all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1) This Order is made on the **** day of ***** 202* and shall come into operation for all purposes on the **** day of *******, 202* and may be cited as the "Sheffield City Council (Avenue Road) (Prohibition of Vehicles) (Map Schedule) Order 202*" ("this Order").

Definitions

- 2) (1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - "the Regulations of 2016" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (as amended);
 - "the Council" means Sheffield City Council;
 - "Electronic Communications Network" has the same meaning as defined in Section 32 of the Communications Act 2003:
 - "Emergency Vehicles" has the same meaning as in The Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations 1989 (as amended).
 - "Junction" in this Order, in relation to measurements of distance, means the Junction of the respective kerb lines of the Roads referred to, and where appropriate, measurements shall be taken from the point of intersection of the respective kerb lines as projected;
 - "Map Schedule" means the collection of plans attached to this Order in Schedule 1.
 - "Plan" and "Plans" means any of the scaled drawings in Schedule 1 to the Order, which show the extent and type of each restriction that applies in this Order;
 - "Road" has the same meaning as that in Section 142 of the 1984 Act;
 - "Traffic Sign" means a sign or marking of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the 1984 Act;
 - "Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order;
 - "Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the 1984 Act and includes any part of a vehicle:
 - (2) A reference to an Article or Schedule followed by a number is a reference to that Article of, or Schedule to, this Order so numbered.

Part II

Moving Traffic Prohibitions

- 3) Prohibited Access All Vehicles
 - (1) Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall cause a Vehicle at any time to proceed in any location in any Road, or part thereof indicated as being prohibited to such traffic by Traffic Signs or in the case of point closures by physical means and is identified as such within the Plans in Schedule 1:

Movement Prohibitions Exceptions

- 4) Those Article 4 exceptions specified in Article 3 are as follows:
 - (a) to a Vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or civil defence purposes, or an ambulance being driven in a case of emergency;
 - (b) shall apply to a mechanical road cleansing vehicle or to any vehicle being used in connection with snow clearing operations;
 - (c) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely –
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road; and
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, line or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any line which is, or forms part of Electronic Communications Network as defined in the Communications Act 2003.
