

THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL
(LODGE MOOR) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 3rd day of April, 2025 the Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 7th day of April, 2025 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the whole or on parts of Balmoral Crescent, Balmoral Glen, Balmoral Mews, Blackbrook Avenue, Blackbrook Drive, Blackbrook Road, Brookhouse Hill, Crimicar Avenue, Crimicar Drive, Crimicar Lane, Harlech Fold, Harlech Green, Harlech Grove, Harlech Mead, Holyrood Avenue, Holyrood View, Kensington Chase, Kensington Court, Kensington Drive, Kensington Park, Moorcroft Avenue, Moorcroft Close, Moorcroft Drive, Moorside, Peterborough Close, Peterborough Drive, Peterborough Road, Redmires Road, Redmires Way, Rochester Close, Rochester Drive, Rochester Road, Sandringham Place, The Fairway, The Pines, Worcester Close, Worcester Drive, Worcester Road.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 3rd April, 2025 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

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The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 having given public notice in accordance with subsection (2) of that section and schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when use in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of April 2025 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Lodge Moor) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2025.
