NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sheffield City Council proposes to make an Order under the provisions of Sections 1, 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124(1)(c), (d) (f) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce:

- No Waiting Monday to Friday 09.00 to 17.30 on part of London Road
- No Waiting Fridays 06:00 to 18:00 on part of Glover Road
- Loading Bay at all times on part of Staveley Road

And remove:

- No Waiting At Any Time on parts of Glover Road, London Road and Staveley Road
- No Loading At Any Time on parts of Glover Road and Staveley Road
- No Loading Monday to Friday 07:30-09:30 and 16:00-18:30 on part of London Road

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Authority's reasons for proposing to make the above named Order(s) are as follows:-

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Explanatory Note:-

The loading bay on Staveley Road provides a specific area for the businesses in that location to load and unload, given the ability to load on Wolseley Road has been removed, to ensure there is adequate forward visibility to the new traffic signals.
