- No Waiting At Any Time on parts of Firth Park Road, Newlyn Road and Ridgeway Road

And remove:

- Free Parking Places Monday to Saturday 08:00-18:30 max stay 1 hour no return for 3 hours on parts of Bellhouse Road and Firth Park Road
- Free Parking Place Monday to Saturday 08:00-18:30 max stay 2 hours no return for 2 hours on parts of Ridgeway Road
- Free Parking Place Monday to Saturday 08:00-18:30 max stay 3 hours no return for 3 hours on parts of Chesterfield Road
