CYCLE TRACKS ORDER 2014

The Sheffield City Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 3(1) of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984, having undertaken the consultations required by Regulation 3 of the Cycle Tracks Regulations 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. The length of footpath described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold black line on the annexed Plan is hereby designated a cycle track.
2. This Order may be cited as the **City of Sheffield (Earl Marshal Road to Rushby Street, Fir Vale) Cycle Tracks Order 2014** and shall come into operation from the date on which this Order is confirmed.

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SCHEDULE

Between Points A and B on the Order Plan

That length of an adopted public footpath extending from point A at its junction with the Earl Marshal Road, located on the northern footway of Earl Marshal Road, opposite house number 270, with a width of 3 metres and continuing for 35 metres in a north-easterly direction to point B as shown on the Order plan.

Between Points B and C on the Order Plan

That length of an adopted public footpath extending from point B with a width of 3 metres and continuing for 32 metres in a westerly direction to point C as shown on the Order plan.

Between Points C and D on the Order Plan

That length of an adopted public footpath extending from point C with a width of 4 metres and continuing for 79 metres in a generally north-westerly direction to point D at its junction with the southern footway of Rushby Street, opposite the rear of house number 116 of Page Hall Road, as shown on the Order plan.

NOTE: The above length of footpath is, by this Order, designated a 'shared facility' cycle track from Earl Marshal Road to Rushby Street.
