NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sheffield City Council proposes to make Orders under the provisions of Sections 1, 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 9, 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53, 84 and 124(1)(c), (d) (f) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders will be to introduce:

- No Waiting at any time on parts of Hounsfield Road and Leavy Greave Road
- No Loading at any time on parts of Hounsfield Road and Leavy Greave Road
- Loading Place on parts of Leavy Greave Road
- Dedicated Disabled Permit Holders Parking Place on parts of Leavy Greave Road
- Prohibition of Motor Vehicles except permit holders on parts of Hounsfield Road and Leavy Greave Road
- One Way Traffic except pedal cycles on parts of Hounsfield Road and Leavy Greave Road

And remove:

- No Waiting at any time on parts of Hounsfield Road
- Loading Place on parts of Leavy Greave Road
- Paid for Parking Places 08:00 to 20:30 on parts of Hounsfield Road and Leavy Greave Road
- Car Club Parking Place on parts of Hounsfield Road

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Authority's reasons for proposing to make the above named Order(s) are as follows

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- For preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property, or
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Explanatory Notes:-

Hounsfield Road and Leavygreave Road are busy pedestrian and cycle routes to the University of Sheffield and the future development of the university in this area will increase pedestrian and cycle flows further. The proposed scheme removes on street parking and restricts traffic movements to prioritise pedestrian and cycle movements along the routes. These routes will connect with existing walking and cycling city centre routes on Leavygreave Road / Portobello with those at Hounsfield Road / Brook Hill.

The proposals improve access by sustainable modes of transport and will provide more space and a safer and more attractive environment for pedestrians and cyclists.

The scheme is proposed in two phases. An interim scheme is proposed whilst the construction of the proposed Combined Teaching Laboratory (CTL) building occurs. A permanent scheme is proposed which will provide new surfacing and landscaping, similar to that implemented on Portobello and Leavy Greave Road to the east of the ring road.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124 (1) (c) (d)and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Sheffield City Council (Stopping Restrictions, Waiting Restrictions, Loading Restrictions and Parking Places)(Map Schedule) Order 2024 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-
 - a) In Part II Parking Places, Article 4 c) thereto was substituted the following item:
 c) if the vehicle is parked in a Disabled Person's Parking Place or a Dedicated Disabled Permit Parking Place and is not displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge in the Relevent Position;
 - b) In Part I Article 2 Defiitions thereto was included the following item: "Dedicated Disabled Permit Holders Parking Place" means the parts of the roads identified on the Plans in Schedule 2 as dedicated disabled permit holders parking places which, subject to the provisions of this Order, is provided for the leaving of a Disabled Person's Vehicle for which a valid Parking Permit has been issued to and indicated by Traffic Signs;
 - c) In Part III Parking Places, Article 2 a) thereto was included the following item:
 iii) in the case of a Dedicated Disabled Permit Holders Parking Place, for the leaving of a vehicle with a Parking Permit that is valid for that Parking Place in accordance with Traffic Signs;
 - d) In Schedule 1 the plans are varied as provided by the following plans attached to Schedule 1 in this Order.
 - 2. This Order shall come into operation on the day of and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Stopping Restrictions, Waiting Restrictions, Loading Restrictions and Parking Places)(Map Schedule) Order 2024 (Amendment No.*) Order 202*.
