Any registered elector may make representations on the current and proposed arrangements. The Council welcomes the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability on its proposals and the (Acting) Returning Officer's representation or any other matter relating to the electoral process.

Where possible, people making representations should suggest alternative places that may be used as polling places.

Representations should be made in writing by no later than **5pm on Wednesday 3 September 2025** to Electoral Services by using the online form on the council's website, by post to Electoral Services, Town hall, Pinstone Street, Sheffield, S1 2HH, or by email to electoralservices@sheffield.gov.uk.

The results of the review will be published by the Council in December 2025 and will be available for inspection on the council's website and the above mentioned offices. Persons or groups making submissions need to be aware that, upon completion of the review, all correspondence/representations received must by law, also be published.
