Who we will share your information with

We will share the results of this survey in an anonymised format with other services within the council, such as MAST and Family Centre services, local community organisations and partners from the Integrated Care System to inform their service delivery, such as Sheffield's children's hospital. They use such information for research and information purposes to inform, influence and improve policy and funding decisions.

How long we keep your information for

Your information will be kept for 3 months to allow us time to analyse the results and this will then be securely deleted. We will keep the information securely and only authorised staff will have access to it.
