Introduction

This booklet lists sources available within Sheffield Libraries Archives and Information for the study of the city's South Asian communities.

It is not a detailed history of South Asian immigration into Sheffield; it merely points the reader who wishes to carry out their own research to what is available within Sheffield Libraries and Archives.

References are included to books, documents, photographs and other items which explicitly refer to the South Asian communities of Sheffield. It does not include own language books or works of fiction. Neither does it include details of books about South Asian countries.

The catalogues of Sheffield Local Studies Library and Sheffield City Archives will contain additional references not listed here. This is because some items will include implicit references to South Asian communities. For instance, there are a large number of reports and documents which refer to wider terms (or terms no longer used) such as 'ethnic minority', 'refugees', 'immigration' or 'race relations'. Using these terms to search the services' catalogues is likely to yield further relevant material.

The earliest references to South Asians being in Sheffield are from the 1920s - in the Darnall area of the city, though it was not until the 1950s and 1960s that immigrants from South Asian countries came to Sheffield, principally to work in the steel and coal mining industries. More detailed research may reveal evidence of settlers from earlier periods than the 1920s.

Timeline showing key dates

1923	Burngreave Cemetery burial register records the burial of Sultan Mohamed (aged 32).
1929	Burngreave Cemetery burial register records the burial of Souriya Khan, (daughter of Ayaht Khan, aged 9 months).
1930s - 1940s	Rasool Khan (known as Gilly Gilly man) believed to have settled in Sheffield from Nartopa in India ¹ . He moved to Liverpool in 1946.
1946	Sheffield's first official mosque was opened in a room on the ground floor of a house on Worksop Road in Attercliffe.
1952	The <i>Sheffield Telegraph</i> reports that men from Aden, Pakistan, India, Egypt and Muslims from the Middle and Far East attended the Feast of Abraham at Attercliffe Baptist Church Hall.
1953	Sheffield Coloured People's Association formed.
1953	Photograph of Muslims gathered for the feast of Eid al-Fitr at Attercliffe Methodist Hall published in <i>The Star</i> .
1955	Account of a meeting of the Sheffield Pakistan Muslim Society published in <i>Sheffield Telegraph</i> .
1955	Sheffield Telegraph reports about 400 Pakistanis living in Sheffield.
1961	Jaima Ismail's dining rooms at No. 61 Attercliffe Common listed in Kelly's directory. The ethnicity of Ismail is not clear. ²
1963	<i>Ajanta</i> Restaurant at 22/24 Carver Street is believed to be the first Indian restaurant listed in Kelly's directory of Sheffield. S. Alkash, dining rooms at 14 Netherthorpe and the <i>Khyber Café</i> at 61 Attercliffe Common are also listed.
1965	The <i>Bombay Restaurant</i> ('Asiatic, Continental and English dishes') is listed at 130/132 Attercliffe Common. The <i>Taj Mahal Restaurant</i> is listed at 349 Ecclesall Road.
1967	Sheffield's oldest surviving Indian restaurant - <i>Ashoka</i> - believed to have opened.
1967	First reference to a mosque in the Sheffield Telephone Book. The Jamia Mosque was situated in Bodmin Street.
1968	Kelly's Directory of Sheffield lists <i>The Curry Inn</i> Restaurant at 169-171 Ecclesall Road; the <i>Kashmir Restaurant</i> at 49 Wicker Street and <i>Raja Restaurant</i> at 235 Abbeydale Road.
1973	Photograph (on www.picturesheffield.com) of mosque on Industry Road.
1976	Attercliffe Pavilion Cinema, Attercliffe Common known for showing Asian films.
1979	Sheffield Asian Welfare Association established.
1981	Bangladesh Citizens Neighbourhood Project (BCNP) established.
1981	First reference to a Sikh temple in the Sheffield Yellow Pages. It was located at 73 Jameson Street

Photographs

Over 80,000 images from the Sheffield Local Studies Library and City Archives collections are available to search online at www.picturesheffield.com. A number of them relate to the South Asian communities.

Trade directories / telephone directories / electoral registers

Trade directories from the 18th century onwards list businesses and private residents in Sheffield. Those from the 1920s onwards in particular may list South Asian families / businesses. Similarly, telephone directories of private residents and the Yellow Pages for businesses may reveal relevant references.

For example, the telephone book for 1966 lists Jalal-ud-Din, butcher, 73 Attercliffe Common; a trade directory for 1974 records Muhammed Khursheed at 13 Industry Road.

Electoral registers are published every year. A search of these will reveal the names and addresses of those with South Asian origins who had the right to vote.

Census returns and population statistics

A population census has been undertaken every 10 years since 1801 (with the exception of 1941). Census returns record details of every citizen including name, address, age, marital status and birth place. Those from 1841 - 1911 are available to view for free at all Sheffield libraries and at Sheffield City Archives via www.findmypast.co.uk

The 1939 Register (containing details of every resident in the UK) is also available via www.findmypast.co.uk

Published statistical reports, which include data on ethnic origin (but not generally broken down by nationality), are available up to the latest census (2011). Copies of statistical reports to 1991 are available at the Reference and Information and Local Studies libraries in the Central Library.

School Records

School admission registers can be useful for studying settlement patterns in the city. Sheffield City Archives has such records for over 200 schools dating from the 19th century. These are kept confidential for 75 years so the earliest ones available for general research are from before 1942. For a detailed list of school records at the City Archives check the collections section at www.sheffield.gov.uk/archives. Contact us for further information on how to access these items.

Business records

It's possible that archives from the steel industry and the coal mining industry may contain references to workers with South Asian origins.
