#### Introduction

#### When to use this form

If you are sending an application to **Sheffield City Council** for an integrated pollution control permit, known as Part A(2) installations, with respect to the preservation of wood and wood products with chemicals with a production capacity exceeding 75m<sup>3</sup> per day other than exclusively treating against sapstain under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 ("the EP Regulations").
