Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (*SI 1992/1215*)

BALL STREET (COVID-19) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2020 ("the Order")

- 1. Sheffield City Council gives notice that it proposes to make the Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway named Ball Street (north east side) from a point 125 metres north east of the northern kerb line of Green Lane for a distance of 6m.
- 2. The Council gives notice that under Section 99 of the RTRA 1984 it is empowered to remove any vehicle which has been permitted to remain at rest contrary to this order in any of the areas of highway as described in paragraph 1 of the Order.
- 3. The Order is needed because of the likelihood of danger to the public and for purposes connected to coronavirus.
- 4. If the Order is made, the Order shall come into operation on 18 August 2020 and shall remain in force for a period of 18 months. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The restriction specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of notices.
- 5. While the Order is in operation: it will prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait or wait for the purposes of loading or unloading in areas of highway as described in paragraph 1 of the Order. Such prohibition shall not apply to pedestrian and vehicular access to frontages, contractor plant and local authority and emergency services vehicles.
- 6. There will be no alternative route for the traffic affected by this order.
