Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215)

QUEENS ROAD & OTHERS (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2020 ("the Order")

1. Sheffield City Council gives notice that it proposes to make the Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over the areas of highway named in the schedules to the Order.
2. The Council gives notice that under Section 99 of the RTRA 1984 it is empowered to remove any vehicle which has been permitted to remain at rest contrary to this order in any of the areas of highway as described in paragraph 1 of the Order.
3. The Order is needed because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said highway and of the likelihood of danger to the public.
4. If the Order is made, the Order shall come into operation on 2 July 2020 and shall remain in force for a period of 18 months. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The restriction specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of notices.
5. While the Order is in operation: it will prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle (except cycles) to proceed in the areas of highway described in Schedule 1 to the Order.
6. The Order will also prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait or wait for the purposes of loading or unloading in areas of highway as described in Schedule 2 to the Order. Such prohibition shall not apply to pedestrian and vehicular access to frontages, contractor plant and local authority and emergency services vehicles.
7. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained at all times.

Schedule 1

St Wilfred's Road at its junction with Queens Road
Cream Street at its junction with Queens Road
Duchess Road, no left turn from Queens Road (north bound)
Duchess Road, no left turn from Queens Road (south bound)

Schedule 2

Queens Road from its junction with Wolseley Road to its junction with Granville Road except between No's 124 and 162 Queens Road (parking and loading) and between No's 270 and 467 Queens Road (loading only)
