

## **SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL**

**Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215)**

### **SHALESMOOR (2) (COVID-19) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2020 ("the Order")**

1. Sheffield City Council makes the Order in exercise of its powers under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 over the areas of highway named in the Schedules to the Order.
2. The Council gives notice that under section 99 of the RTRA 1984, and Regulation 5 of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, it is empowered to remove any vehicle which has been permitted to remain at rest contrary to this Order in any of the roads listed in the Schedule to the Order.
3. The Order, and the prohibitions set out below, are necessary because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads listed in the Schedule to the Order and for purposes connected to coronavirus.
4. If the Order is made, the Order shall come into operation on 4 July 2020 and shall remain in force for a period of three days. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The restriction specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of notices.
5. Whilst the Order is in effect it will prohibit:
  - a. Any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed, or cause or permit any vehicle to wait, or wait for the purposes of loading or unloading, over the areas of highway listed in Schedule 1 to the order; and,
  - b. Any person from using, including entering or remaining in, those areas of highway listed in Schedule 1 to the order.
6. The Order shall also prohibit any person from allowing any vehicle to proceed in a westbound direction (from Shalesmoor Roundabout) in the area listed in schedule 2 to the Order thus permitting traffic to temporarily flow in a one way system in an eastbound direction only (towards Shalesmoor Roundabout).
7. The alternative route for the traffic affected by this order will be signed on site.
