Experimental Traffic Regulation Order

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 15th day of September, 2020 The Sheffield City Council made the above Order which comes into operation on the 24th day of September, 2020 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce Limited Waiting 20 minutes, no return within one hour, Monday to Friday 8.00 am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.00pm on parts of Kirk Edge Road outside Bradfield School.

A copy of the Experimental Order, plans showing the roads concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for the Order may be examined during normal opening hours at First Point Reception, Howden House, 1 Union Street, Sheffield, S1 2SH or on the City Council Website at https://www.sheffield.gov.uk/home/roads-pavements/covid-19-traffic-orders

The City Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person wishing to object to the making of an Order for such indefinite continuation may do so, giving the grounds for the objection, in writing, to The Director of City Growth, at the address given below within a period of six months from the 17th September, 2020.

Any alterations to this Order which will render it less restrictive may be authorised by the Head of Strategic Transport, Sustainability and Infrastructure without the requirement to re-advertise the Order under Section 10(2) of the said Act, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 17th September, 2020, make application for that purpose to the High Court.

 The Sheffield City Council (Consolidation) (On-Street Parking And Prohibition Of Waiting) (Outer Area) Order 2008 (as amended) shall have effect as though in Schedule 5.61 there was included the following items:-


Kirk Edge Road

The north side:

- (i) From a point 156.5 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of Briarfields Lane for a distance of 61.5 metres in a westerly direction.
- (ii) From a point 248 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of Briarfields Lane for a distance of 40 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of September, 2020 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Kirk Edge Road) (Experimental Traffic) (Limited Waiting) Order 2020.
