NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2022 the Sheffield City Council made the above Orders which come into operation on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2022 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders will be to introduce Permit holders only parking at all times on parts of Hawley Street Flats Car Park and Lansdowne Flats Car Parks;

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2022, make application for that purpose to the High Court.
