STATEMENT OF REASONS

This scheme is a pedestrian accessibility scheme on Burton Street to improve the access and visibility for pedestrians crossing, especially those crossing between the two sites of The Burton Street Foundation. There have been concerns that drivers are not aware of the crossing movements and that the parked vehicles block the sight lines of drivers and pedestrians. The local businesses also require a loading bay for loading and unloading goods close to premises.

The introduction of these measures will address the localised traffic concerns, improve road safety for pedestrians, improve access to local facilities and support local business needs.
