

## What happens when you leave a mainstream school to home educate?


### Step 1

You should tell your child's school that you have decided to home educate. This will stop your child being registered as 'missing in education'.



### Step 2

Your school will inform the local authority that your child will no longer be attending.



### Step 3

The Multi Agency Support Team (MAST) will contact you. They will ask to meet you and your child to discuss your decision and offer support.




### Step 4

The Home Education Advisor will contact you and ask for information about your home education. You will receive information through the post and/or be offered a visit.



### Step 5

The Home Education Advisor will contact you again after a few weeks to see how your home education is progressing.



### Step 6

Further visits or meetings may be arranged if your home education is not full time or suitable.



### Step 7

You will be contacted at least on an annual basis to let us know that your home education is still full time and suitable to your child's needs.
