

# Positive Behaviour Support Training

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) is an approach used with people who have learning disabilities and or Autism, whose behaviour limits their opportunities or challenges others.

This training is suitable for anyone working with individuals with Learning disabilities and or Autism who would like to learn about the principles of PBS.
