I, Kate Josephs, being the Counting Officer at the Referendum on how Sheffield City Council is run held on 6 May 2021, do hereby give notice that the question put to the electorate was as follows:

'How would you like Sheffield City Council to be run?'

The number of votes cast is follows:

Number of votes	
By a leader who is an elected councillor chosen by a vote of other elected councillors. This is how the council is run now.	48,727
By one or more committees made up of elected councillors. This would be a change from how the council is run now.	89,670
