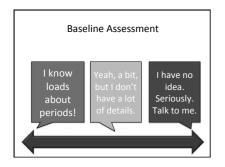




#periodpositive has been recognised by leading sexual health charities Brook and FPA for delivering innovative sex and relationships education to young people.

FPA Chief Executive Natika Halil said: "We hope that the programme being delivered by #periodpositive will be replicated across the country, so that all young people can benefit."













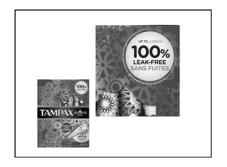

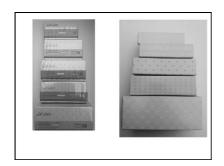


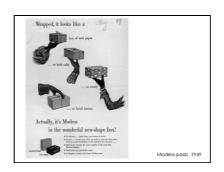












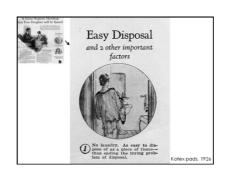




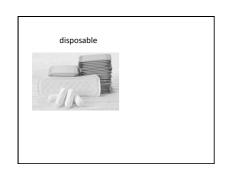


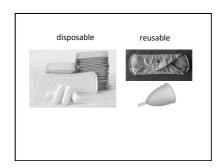


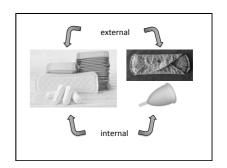












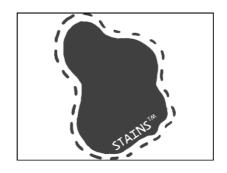
Managing Periods:

The Charter will support schools to evidence that:

- the school environment supports young people to manage menstruation easily in order to maximise learning time, attendance and focus
- attendance and rocus

 supporting pupils' menstruation education, both formally and in teachable moments
- subject specialists and pastoral staff are prepared for upcoming National Curriculum guidelines for RSE.

Free and UNBRANDED resources. Talk about advertising, taboo + media literacy. Example kits that include different types of products like cloth pads and menstrual cups. Teach the boys (and men!) too! Include trans/nonbinary menstruators.
