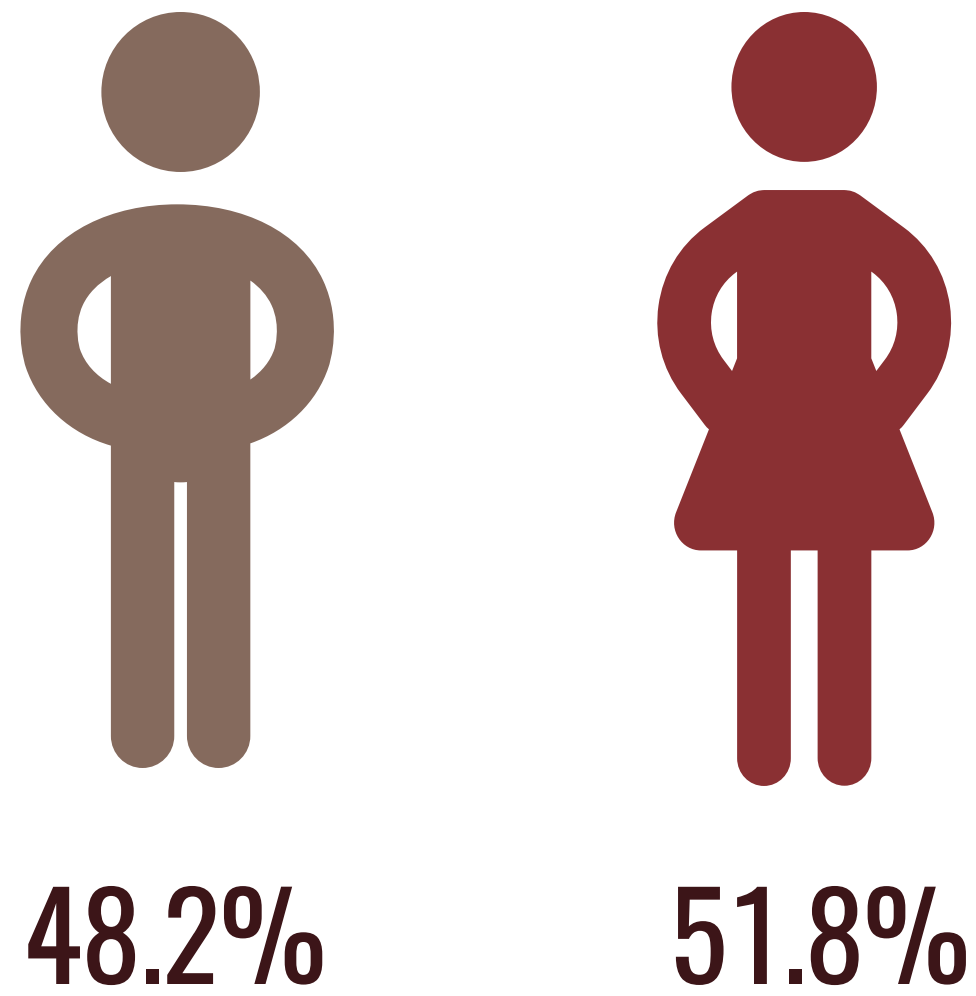

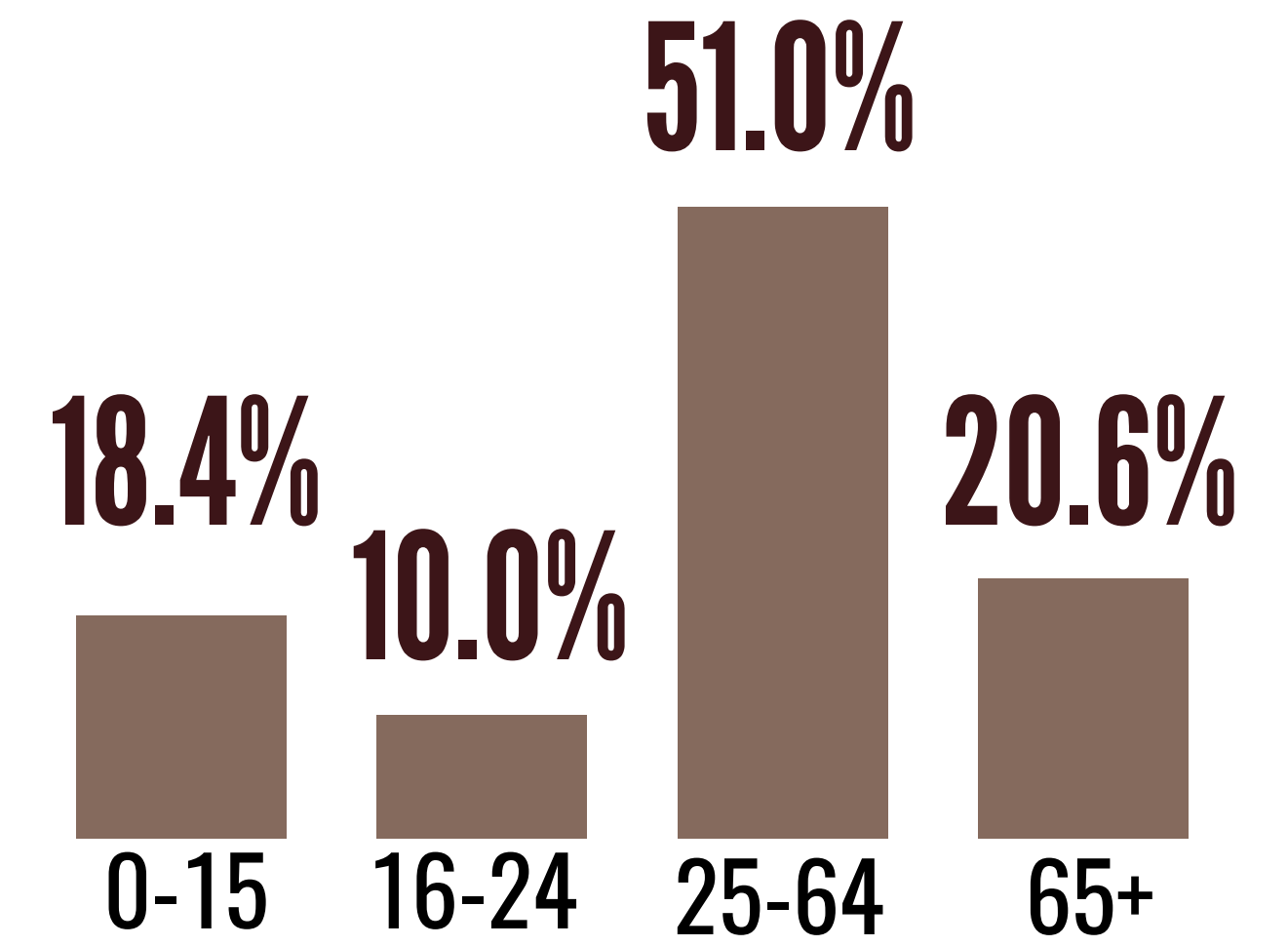

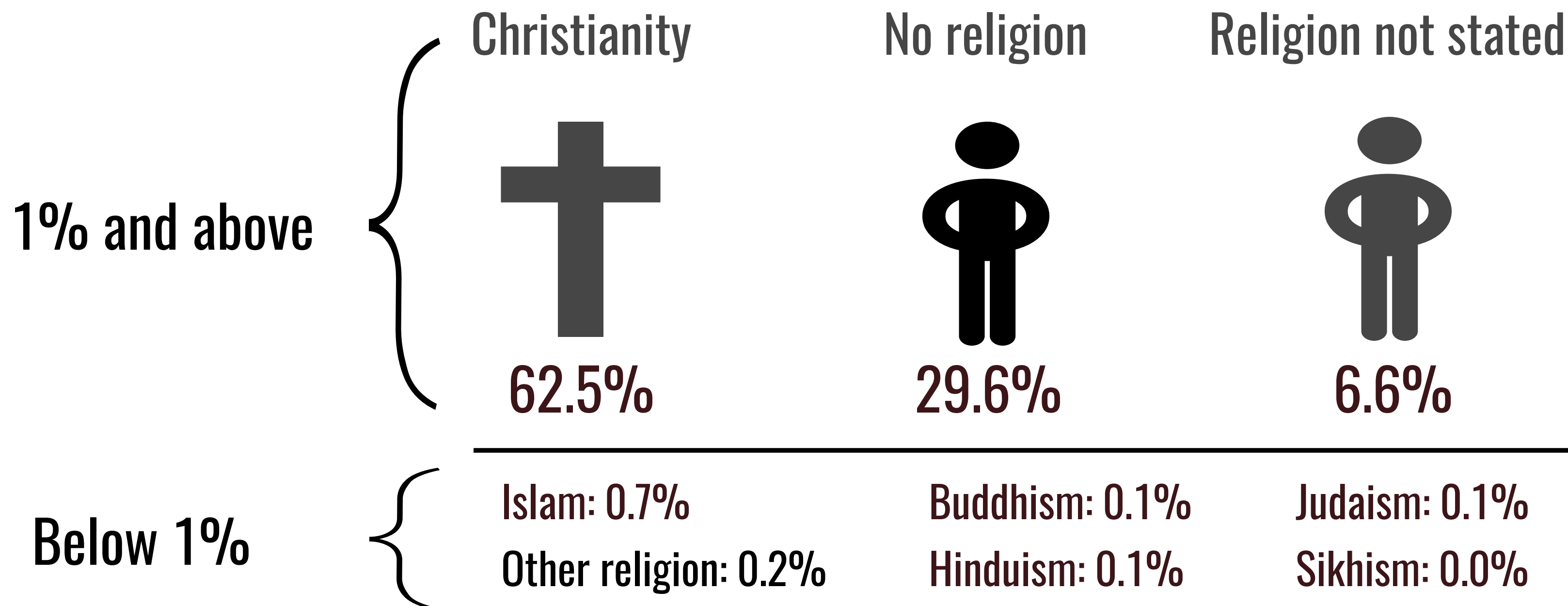

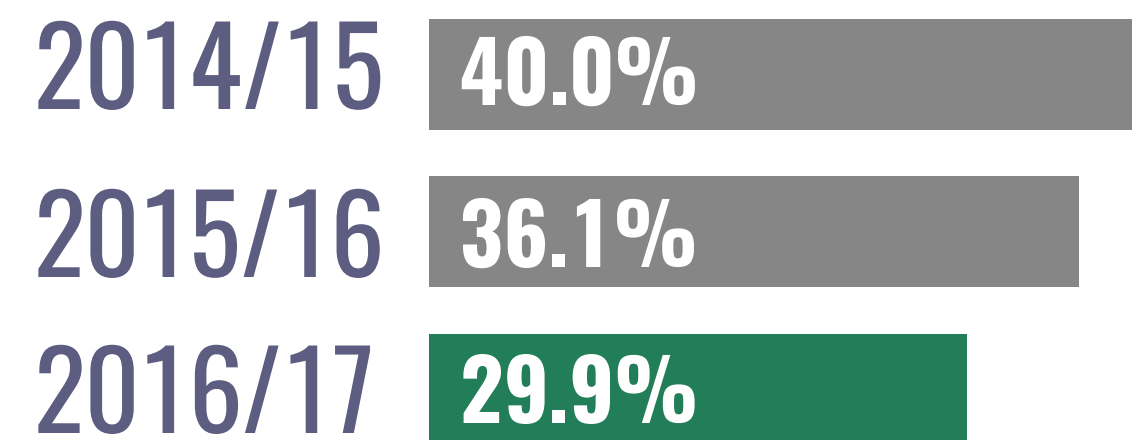

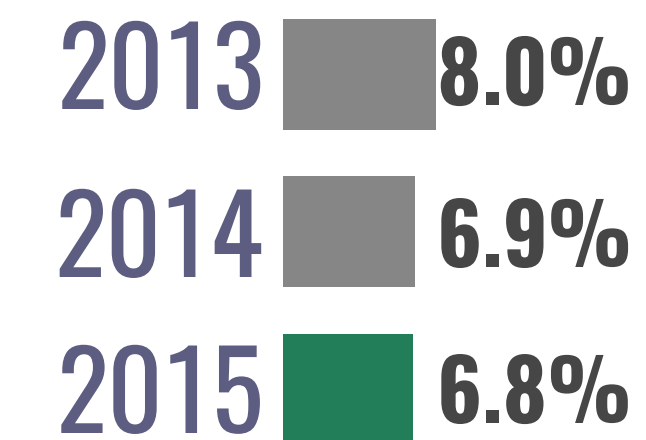

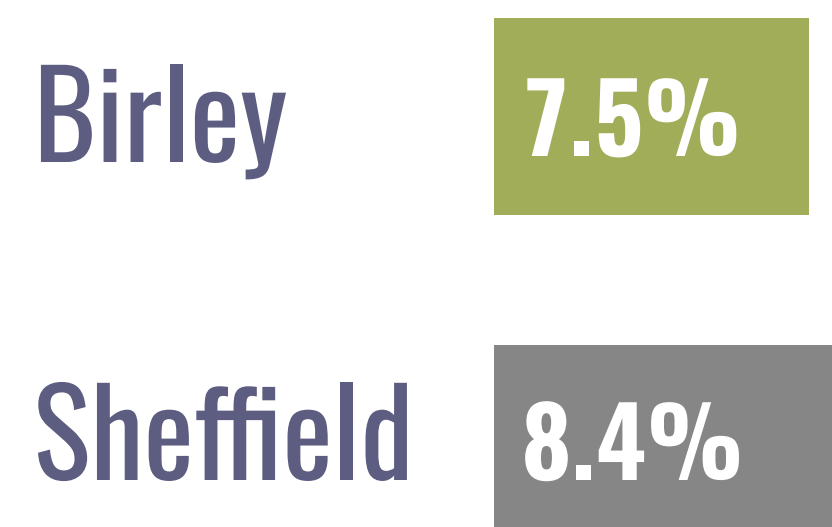

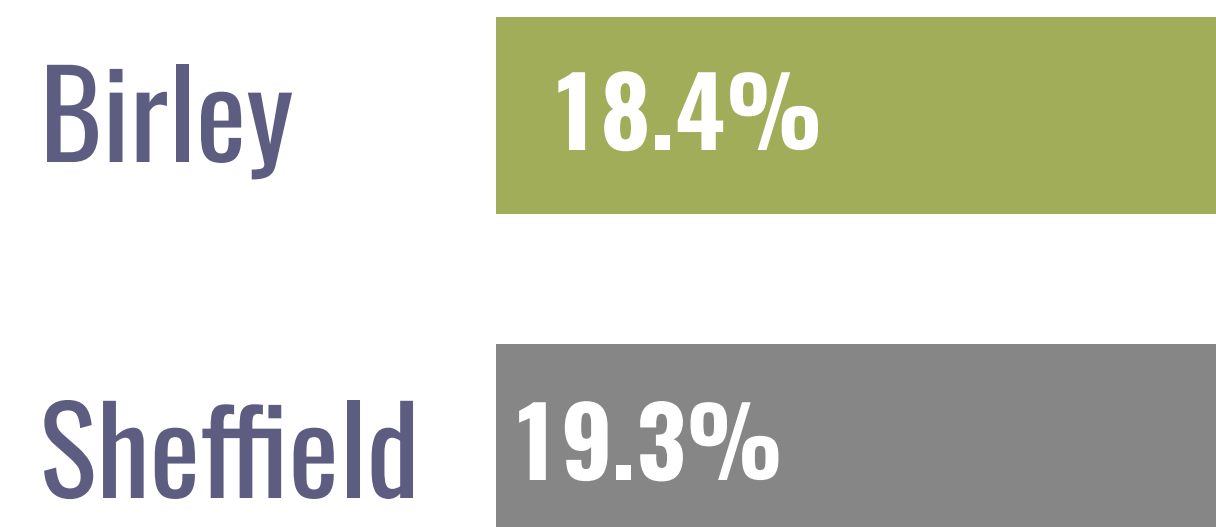

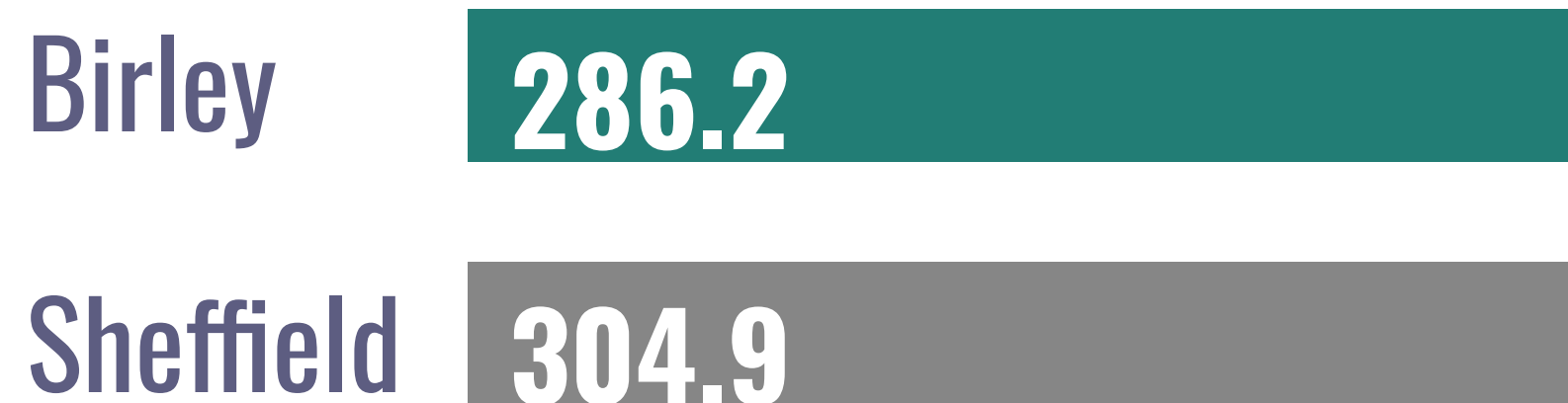

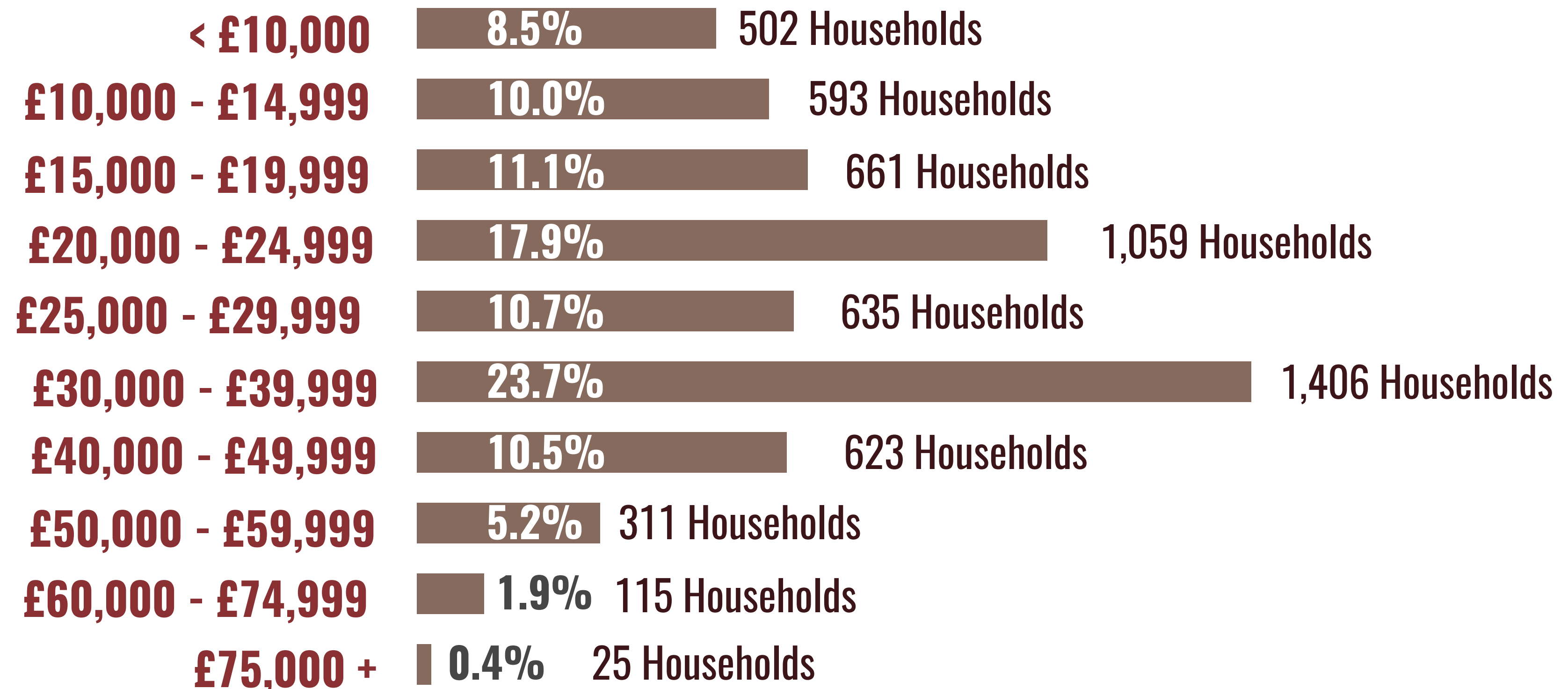

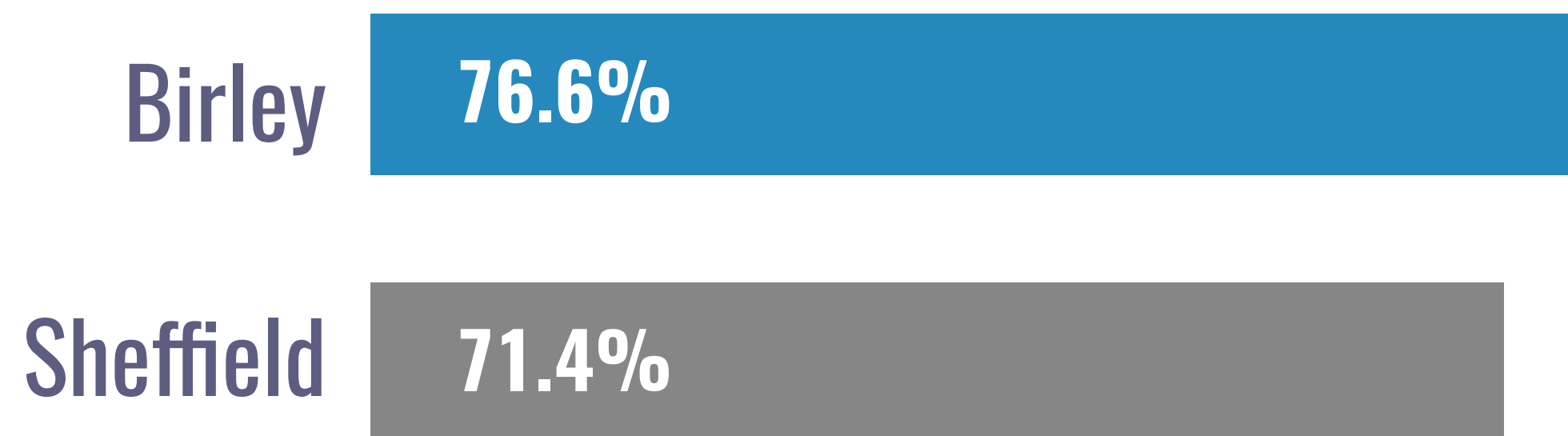

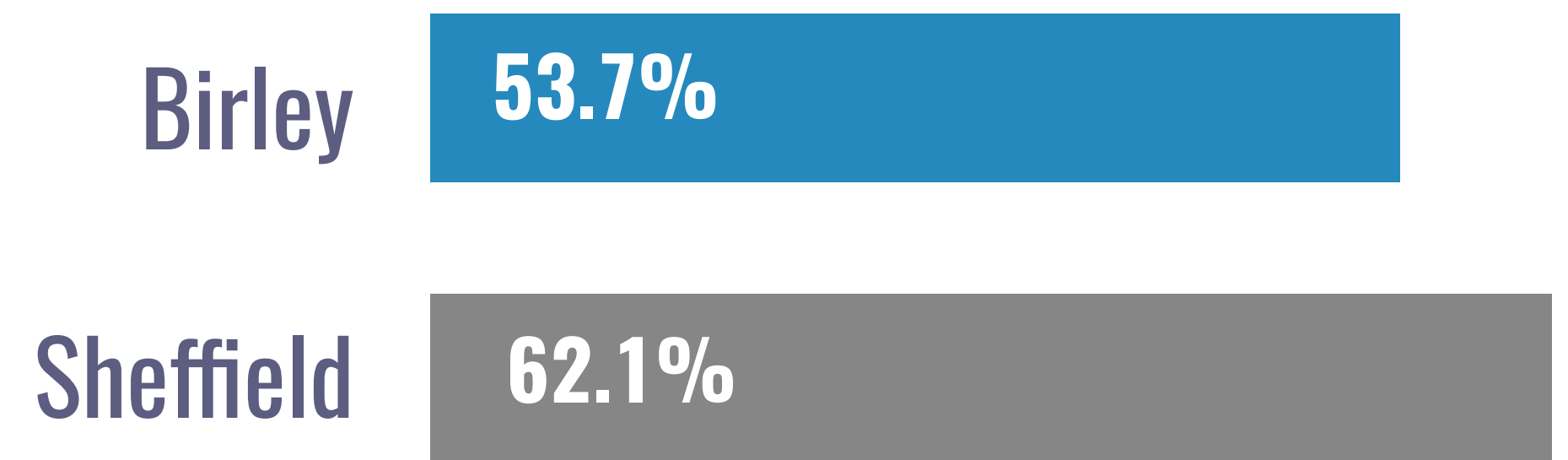

Percentage of pupils reaching the expected standard of reading (2016)

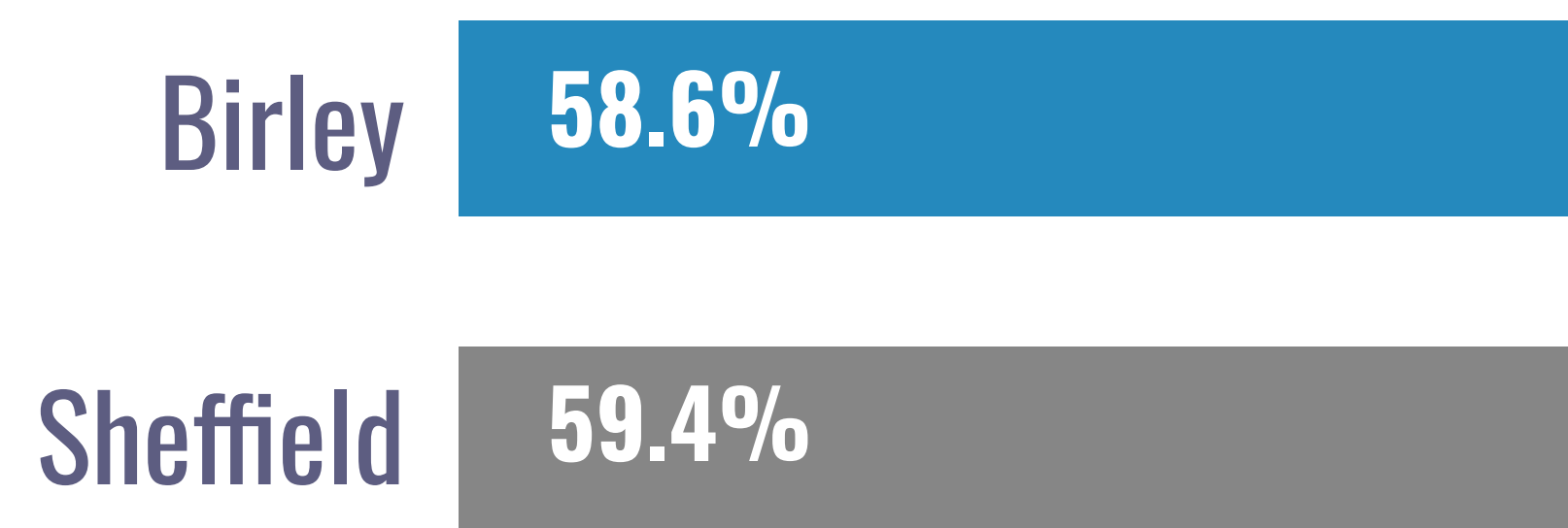

Percentage of pupils achieving grade C or above in English and Maths at Key Stage 4 (GCSE)



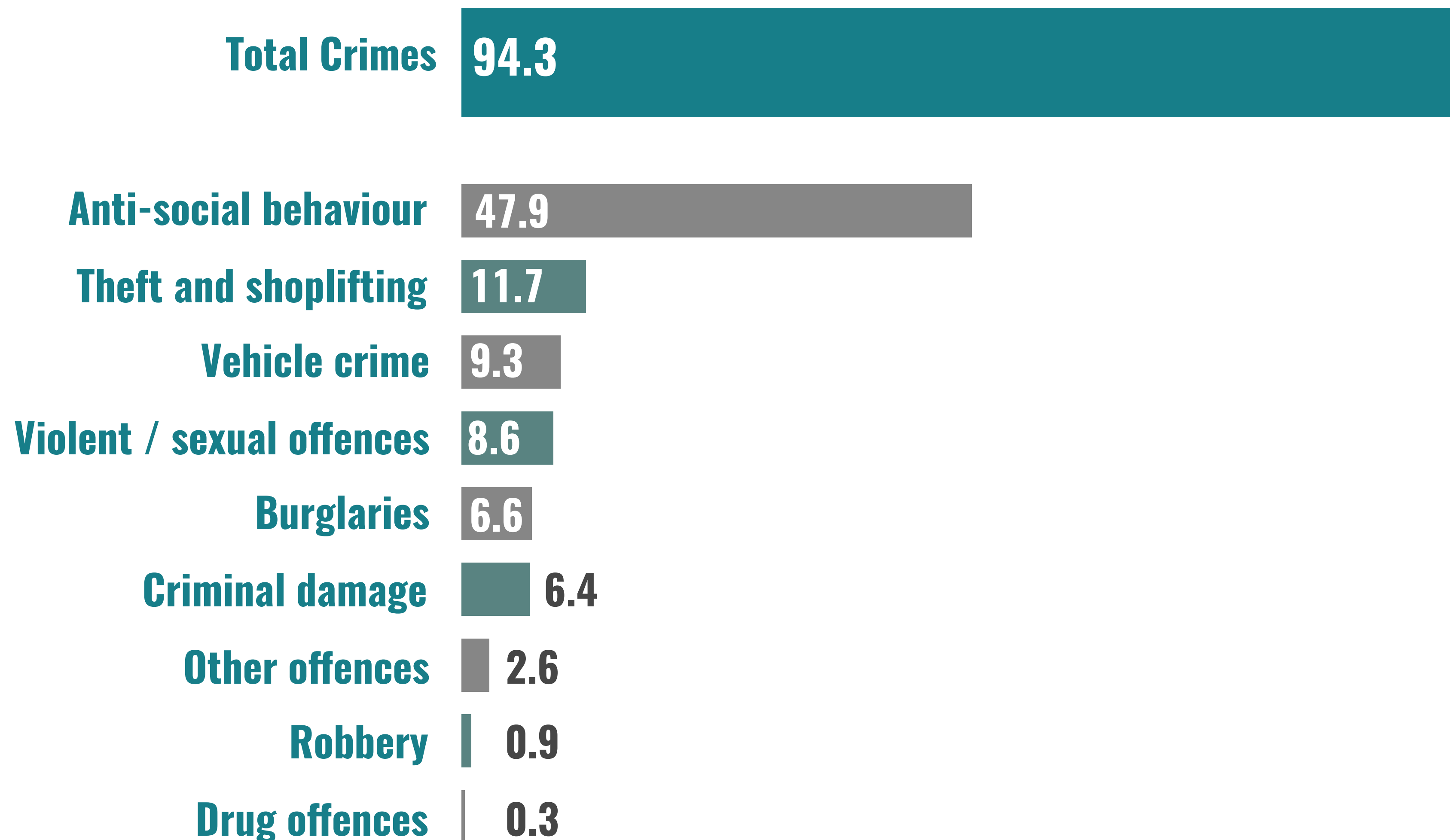
