This Order is made by the Sheffield City Council ('the Authority) under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the 1980 Act) because it appears to the Authority that the footpaths described in paragraph 1 below are not needed for public use.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public rights of way over the land situate in the Burncross area of Sheffield shown by a continuous bold line on the Map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished within 365 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order the statutory undertakers shall continue to enjoy all such rights in respect of any apparatus belonging to them on, under, adjacent or over the land referred to in paragraph 1 hereof as they may have hitherto enjoyed.

SCHEDULE

A public footpath with a recorded width of 3 feet commencing at a point marked A on the order map (grid reference 434135:396568), point A being located at the southern footway of Stanley Road 30 metres east of the junction with Livingstone Road, then continuing in a generally south easterly direction for a distance of 169m to a point marked B on the order map (grid ref: 434162:396400), point B being located at the junction with paths ECC\32A and ECC\32B.
