PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2018

This Order is made by the Sheffield City Council ('the Authority') under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the 1980 Act') because it appears to the Authority that the footpaths described in paragraph 1 below are not needed for public use.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situate in the Ecclesfield area of Sheffield shown by a continuous bold line on the Map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished within 365 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order the statutory undertakers shall continue to enjoy all such rights in respect of any apparatus belonging to them on, under, adjacent or over the land referred to in paragraph 1 hereof as they may have hitherto enjoyed.

SCHEDULE

Footpath ECC\80 commencing at a point marked A on the order map (grid reference 435567:393835), point A being located at its junction with High Street, then continuing in a south westerly direction along Well Lane for a distance of 44m to a point marked B on the order map (grid ref: 435537:393806), then continuing in a generally south easterly direction for a distance of 106m to a point marked C on the order map (grid ref: 435568:393709), then continuing in a generally easterly direction for a distance of 106m to a point marked D on the order map, then continuing in an easterly direction for a distance of 24m to a point marked E on the order map (grid ref: 435670:393658) that point being located where the path meets the bridleway ECC\81.

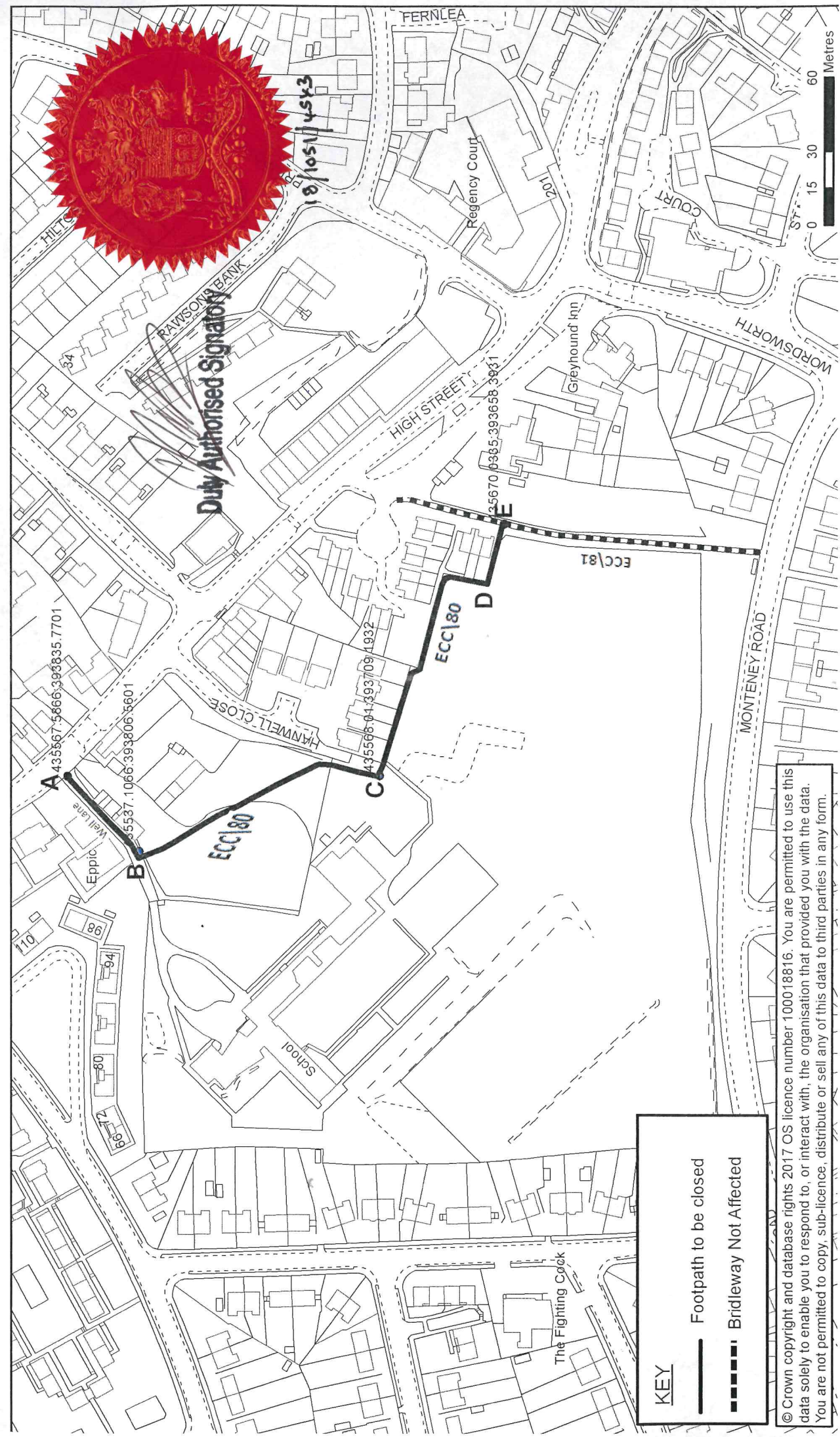
