CITY OF SHEFFIELD (FOOTPATH OFF OVEREND WAY, GLEADLESS VALLEY) DIVERSION ORDER 2017

This Order is made by Sheffield City Council (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely a residential development, provision of means of access, associated landscaping and the formation of a link road and engineering works.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The footpaths over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached Map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule'), shall be diverted as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached Map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which the Proper Officer, Culture and Environment, of the Council certifies that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
- 4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpaths are stopped up there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across them belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1 Description of sites of existing paths or ways

A public footpath with a variable width between 3 and 10 metres, commencing at point A on the Order Map (grid ref. 437116:383465), that point being located 28 metres north west from the entrance at the western boundary of the electricity substation, then continuing in a south easterly direction for a distance

of 31.5 metres to point B on the Order Map (grid reference 437147:383448) then continuing in a south westerly direction for a distance of 35 metres to point C on the Order Map (grid ref. 437154:383415).

PART 2 Description of site of alternative highways

A public footpath with a width of 3 metres, commencing at point A on the Order Map (grid ref. 437116:383465), that point being located 31 metres north west from the entrance at the western boundary of the electricity substation, then continuing in a south easterly direction for a distance of 53 metres to point C on the Order Map (grid ref. 437154:383415).


