This Order is made by the Sheffield City Council ('the Authority) under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the 1980 Act) because it appears to the Authority that the footpaths described in paragraph 1 below are not needed for public use.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public rights of way over the land situate in the City Centre area of Sheffield shown by a continuous bold line on the Map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished within 365 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order the statutory undertakers shall continue to enjoy all such rights in respect of any apparatus belonging to them on, under, adjacent or over the land referred to in paragraph 1 hereof as they may have hitherto enjoyed.

SCHEDULE

A public footpath with a recorded width of 4 feet commencing at a point marked A on the order map (grid reference 428124:398490), point A being located at the intersection with footpath STO/10 then continuing in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of 66m to a point marked B on the order map (grid ref: 428176:398530), then continuing in a generally north northeasterly direction for a distance of 34m to a point marked C on the order map (grid ref: 428187:398562), that point being located where the path meets the southern boundary of the highway at the roundabout Fox Valley Way/A616 Stocksbridge Bypass.
